



This energy is reflected in this Kaleidoscope of different activities.






THINK GREEN, GO GREEN – VAN MAHOTSAV CELEBRATIONS. "I AM DOING MY BIT"










- Brainstorming Activity helped the students to express and pen down their ideas freely without any inhibitions.









Fun with Maths - Paper cutting and folding is an origami art to explore their dexterity.

Maths activities are conducted so as to encourage the students to relate the abstract with reality. Activities to prove Properties of line and to show open and closed curves.










TOPIC: CHANGES AROUND US


<u>ACTIVITY</u>: TO OBSERVE THE IRREVERSIBLE-IRREVERSIBLE CHANGES BY PAPPER FOLDING, CUTTING AND MIXING TWO DIFFERENT SUBSTANCES.

TO OBSERVE AND FIGURE OUT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN REVERSIBLE AND IRREVERSIBLE CHANGES, AN ACTIVITY WAS CONDUCTED WITH THE STUDENTS OF CLASS 6 WHERE THEY THEMSELVES FOLDED A SHEET AND TORE A SHEET TO INFER THAT THE FOLDING OF PAPER IS A REVERSIBLE CHANGE AND CUTTING OF PAPER IS AN IRREVERSIBLE CHANGE.

SIMILARLY, THEY DISSOLVED SALT AND SOAP IN WATER TO IDENTIFY WHICH IS A REVERSIBLE CHANGE AND WHICH IS AN IRREVERSIBLE CHANGE.


