An activity based on the importance of investment was done. A question was posed to the students in advance “Why should one invest?”

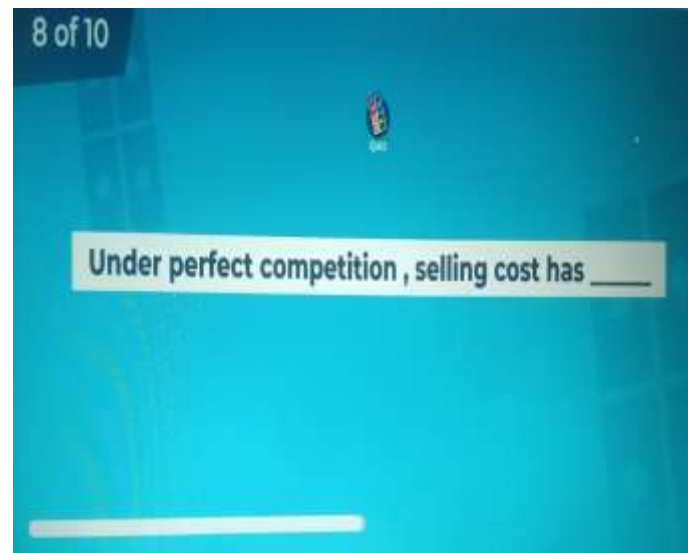

## Quiz Activity:

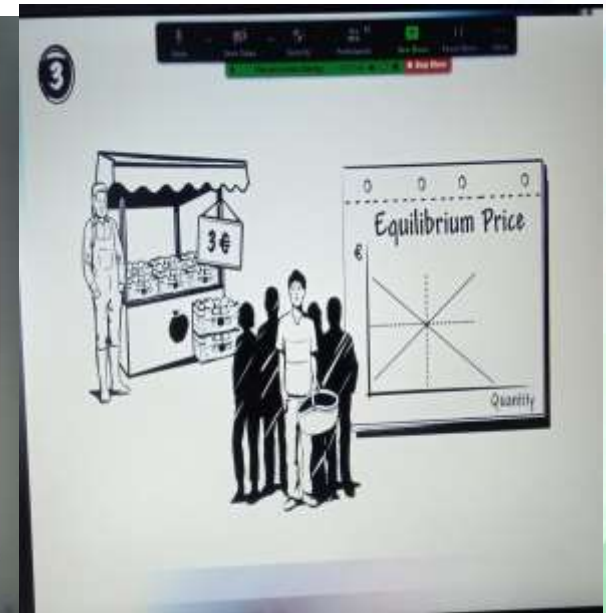
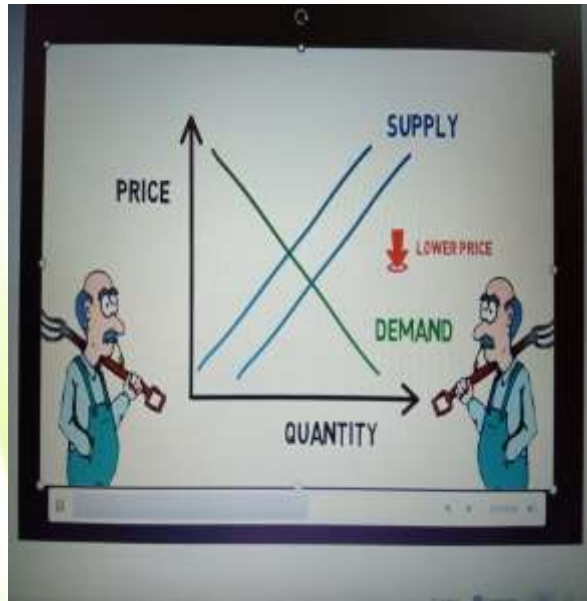

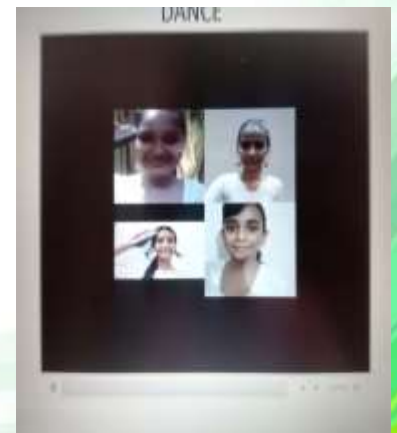
## FOLKLORE ACTIVITY:
