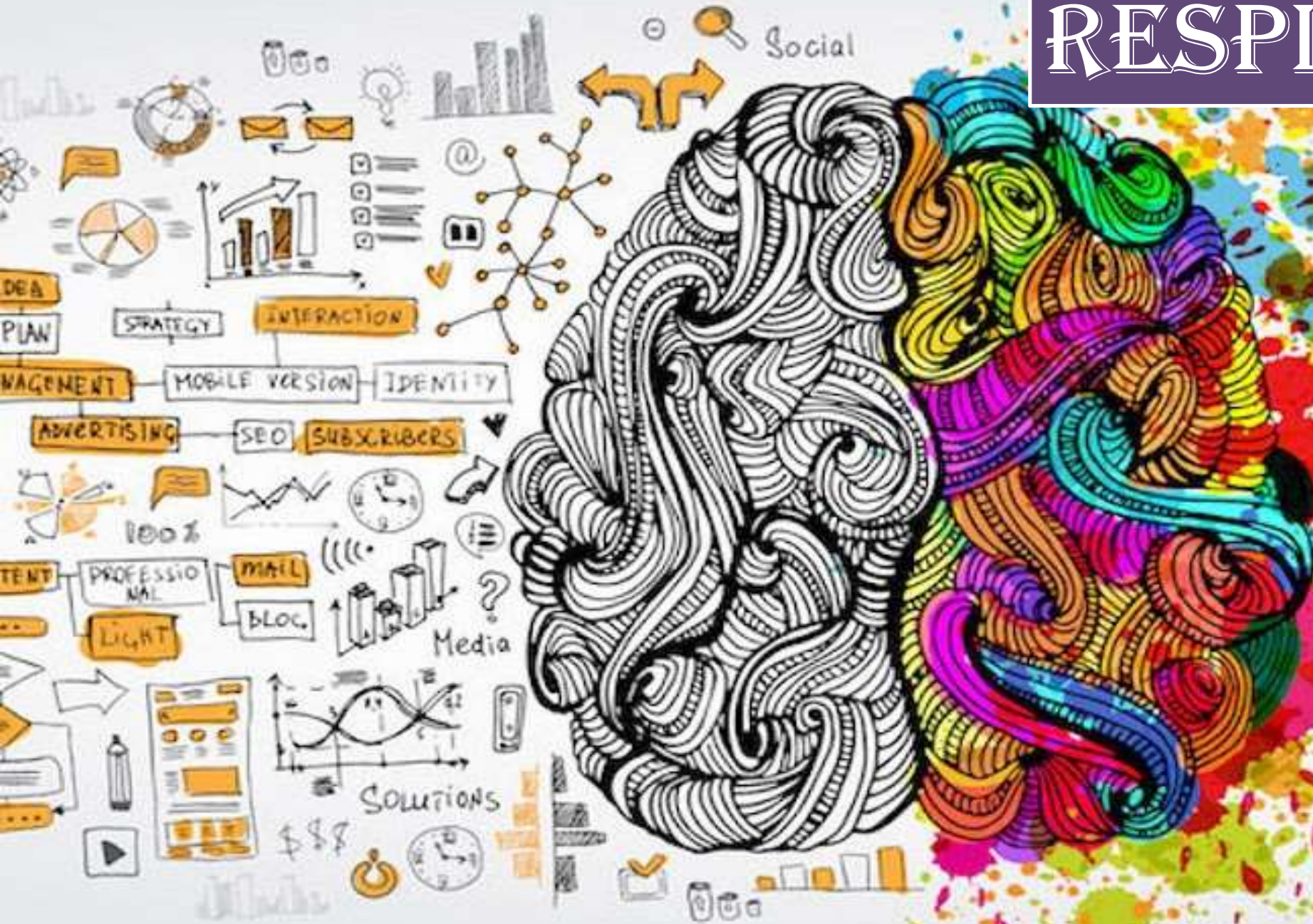

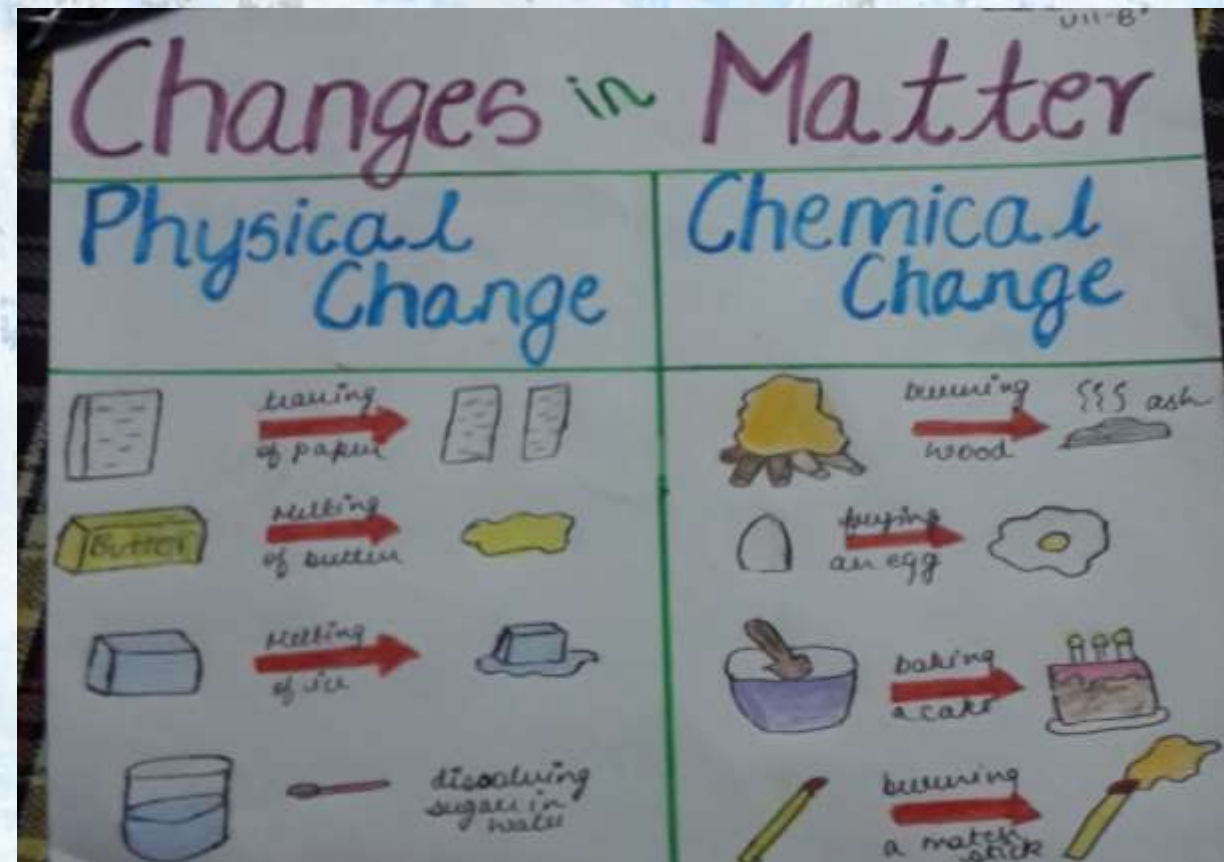
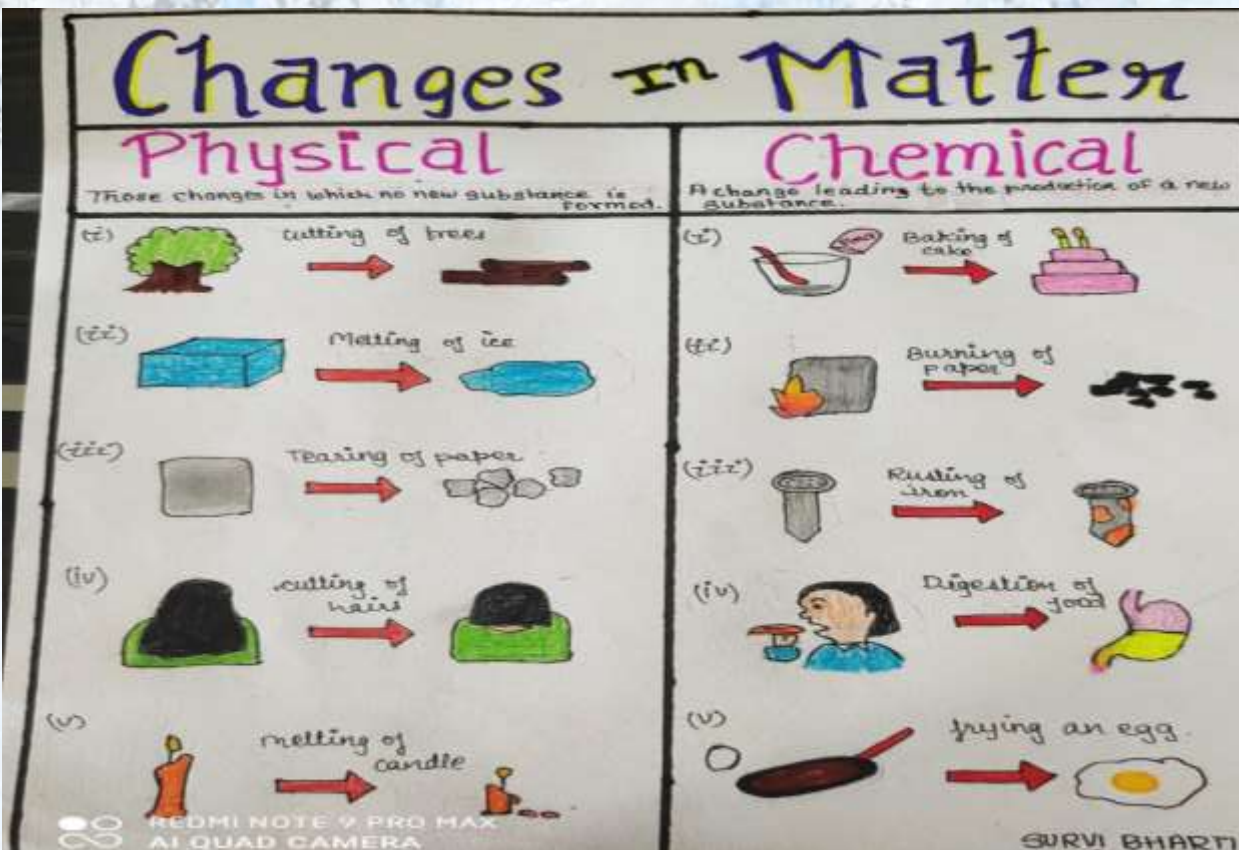

ENGLISH WEEK CELEBRATED

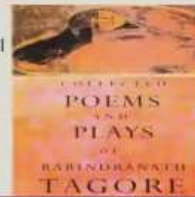
The students shared information about the famous poet Rabindranath Tagore through THE PowerPoint Presentations.

- He was the first Non-European to win a Nobel Prize in Literature.
- Mahatma Gandhi has given the title "Gurudev" to Rabindranath Tagore.
- His sister Swarna Kumari Devi was also a well known Novelist.
- His Nobel prize was stolen on 25 March 2004.
- He has written National Anthem of 3 Nations, they were:
 1. For India ("Jana Gana Mana")
 2. For Sri Lanka ("Sri Lanka Matha")
 3. For Bangladesh ("Amar Sonar Bangla")
- He made a school from his novel prize named "Visva Bharti".

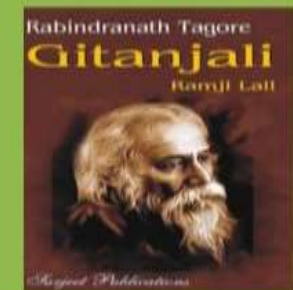

WHO WAS RABINDRANATH TAGORE ?

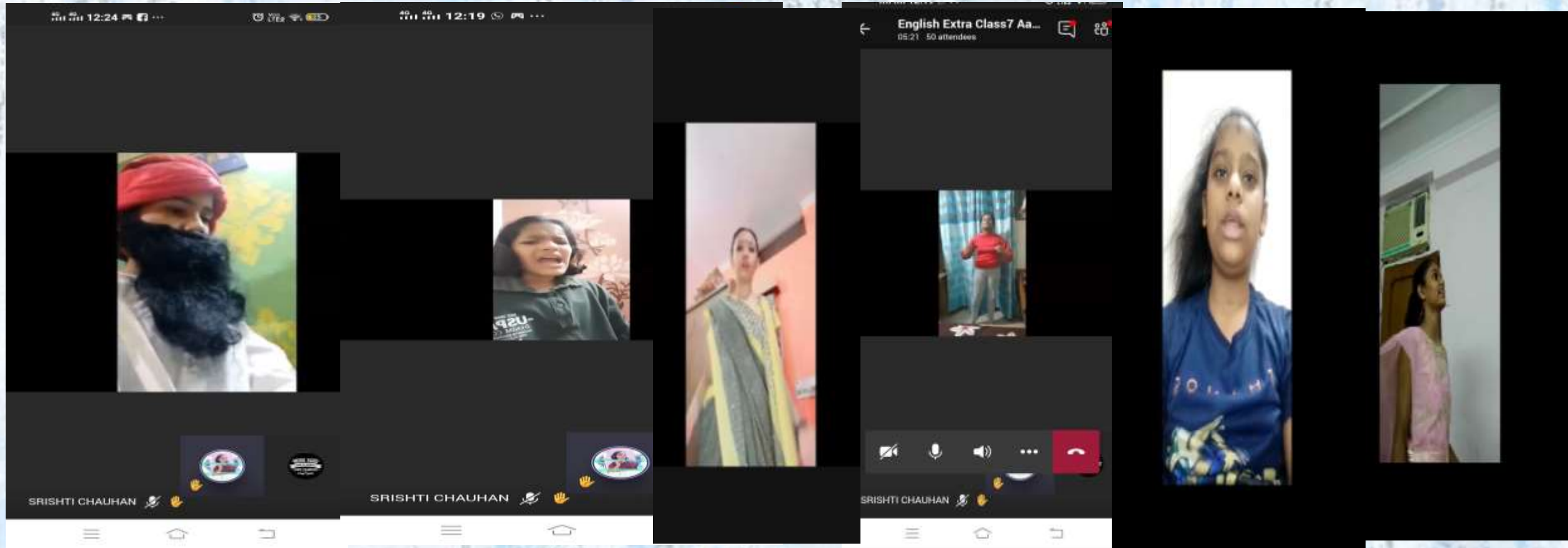
- Rabindranath Tagore FRAS, sobriquets Gurudev, was a Bengali polymath-poet, writer, composer, philosopher and painter.

- RABINDRANATH TAGORE DEDICATED THIS POEM FOR OUR MOTHERLAND INDIA.
