


Children expressed their feeling about the nationalist and highlighted their contribution in national movements in India.

Such activity enhances spatial thinking which allows students to comprehend and analyze phenomena related to the places and spaces around them.




DISTRIBUTION OF OIL FIELDS AND COAL FIELDS ON A POLITICAL MAP OF INDIA









MATHS IS A PROBLEM, THINKING IS A SOLUTION


Activity of linear equation and probability was done in class. Students participated enthusiastically and shared their work.





















ENGLISH MONTH POET OF THE MONTH-WILLIAM BLAKE




The Students
