ENGLISH WEEK ACTIVITIES:

Following the tradition, we celebrated the English Week with myriad of activities like previous years. It was an exhilarating and enriching experience for students.

- A. We started with discussing about a famous Indian children author, R. K. Narayan. Talked about how his pieces of writing are relevant for all age groups by making the plot interlaced with political activities in a very subtle style. His biography with major works was introduced to the kids.
- B. A cinematic adaptation of a story of 'Malgudi Days' was shown and discussed. Students enthusiastically gave inputs and gained a lot information on how to analyse a creative text with some basic artistic lenses.







On the third day, Parsody- the study of a literary technique of meter, intonation, and rhythm of a poetic work was discussed. Morning assembly helps in building a culture of communication and representation of academic and co-curricular activities. They are a very important part of school culture. It helps to strengthen the way a school works.






Quiz Activity:
