





A small quiz was conducted in the class wherin the students framed sentences in direct speech and others changed them into indirect speech and vice versa.








HAPPINESS CURRICULUM

Gratitude was introduced to the students. They were taught the value of gratitude through the small videos.




CREATIVITY AT IT'S BEST FOR CHRISTMAS

I hope it comes true




