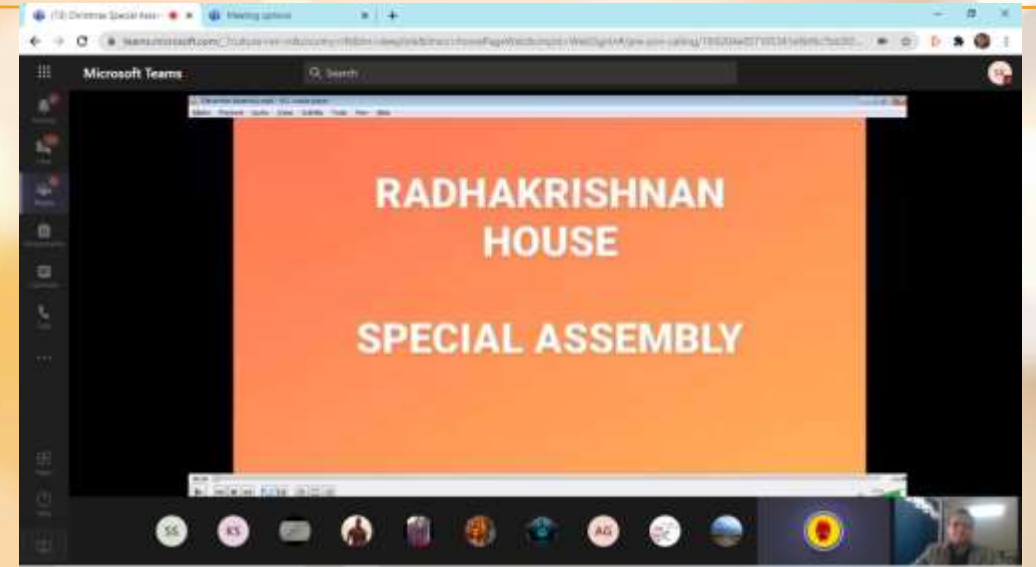

Joy of Christmas

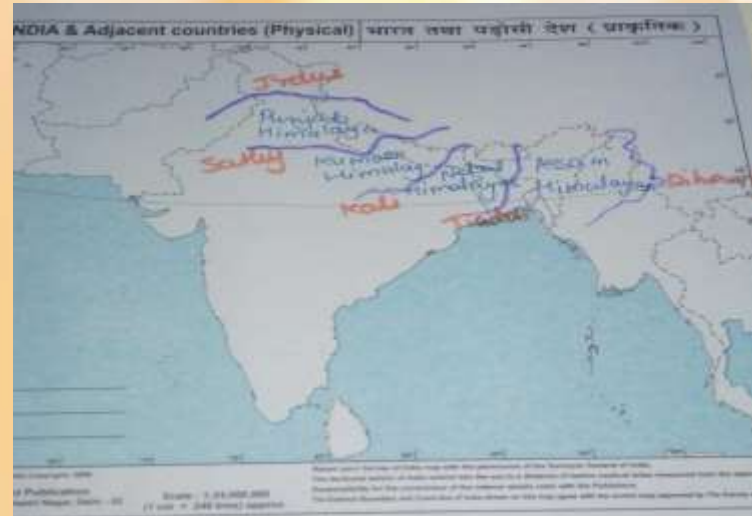
Christmas is like a joy,

# ART INTEGRATION

## INTERESTING FACTS



- Sikkim has become India's first fully organic state by converting around **75,000** hectares of agricultural land into sustainable cultivation.
- Sikkim in **1998** became the first Indian state to ban disposable plastic bags.
- Study found that around **66** per cent of shops in Sikkim used paper bags or newspapers and around **34** per cent used plastic bags, which includes non-woven bags.
- It banned the use of Styrofoam and thermocool disposable plates and cutlery in the entire state in a move to cut down toxic plastic pollution and tackle its ever-increasing garbage problem.
- In **2016** It banned the use of packaged drinking water in government offices and government events.

- Traditional local festivals, such as Maghe Sankranti, Sakela, Chasok Tangnam and Bhimsen Puja, are popular. Losar, Saga Dawa, Lhabab Duechen, Drukpa Teshi and Bhumchu are among the Buddhist festivals celebrated in Sikkim.

- Sikkim is a state in northeastern India.
- Sikkim is the least populous and second smallest among the Indian states.
- Sikkim is notable for its biodiversity including alpine and subtropical climates, as well as being a host to Kangchenjunga the highest peak in India and third highest on Earth.
- Sikkim's capital and largest city is Gangtok.
- Sikkim accounts for the largest share of cardamom production in India, and is the world's second largest producer of the spice after Guatemala.
