A Virtual Fitness Fiesta was organised for classes Nurs- XII where Inter House competitions were held. An opening ceremony was organised for the students and parents.





















THE SEASON TO BE JOLLY AND GENEROUS




ACTIVITY: MAP SHOWING FLOW OF RIVERS & LAKES











ART INTEGRATION

Art Integration is now an indispensible part of our curriculum. The students were asked to design PPts around the partner state.



- Sikkim in 1998 became the first Indian state to ban disposable plastic bags.
- Study found that around 66 per cent of shops in Sikkim used paper bags or newspapers and around 34 per cent used plastic bags, which includes non-woven bags.
- It banned the use of Styrofoam and thermocol disposable plates and cutlery in the entire state in a move to cut down toxic plastic pollution and tackle its ever-increasing garbage problem.
- In **2016** It banned the use of packaged drinking water in government offices and government events.



ABOUT SIKKIM



- o Sikkim is a state in northeastern India.
- o Sikkim is the least populous and second smallest among the Indian states.
- o Sikkim is notable for its biodiversity including alpine and subtropical climates, as well as being a host to Kangchenjunga the highest peak in India and third highest on Earth.
- O Sikkim's capital and largest city is Gangtok.
- o Sikkim accounts for the largest share of cardamom production in India, and is the world's second largest producer of the spice after Guatemala.
