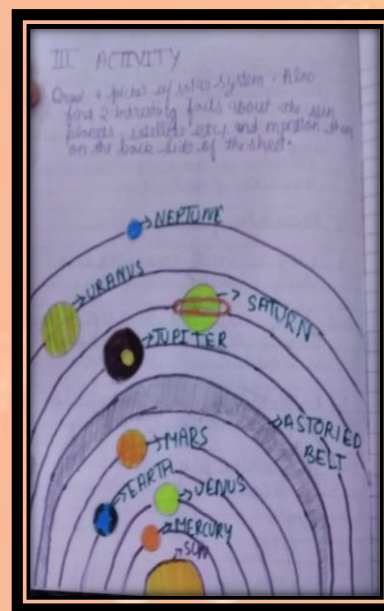
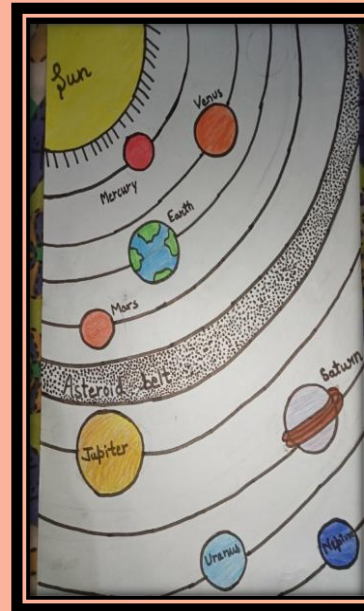
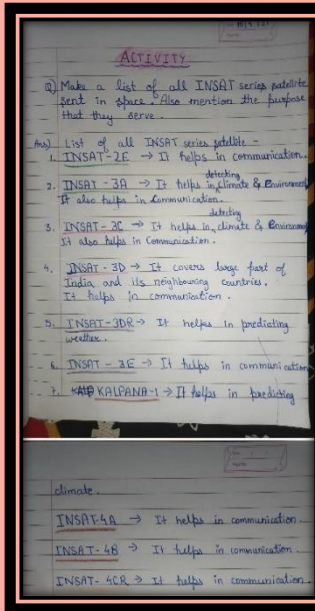
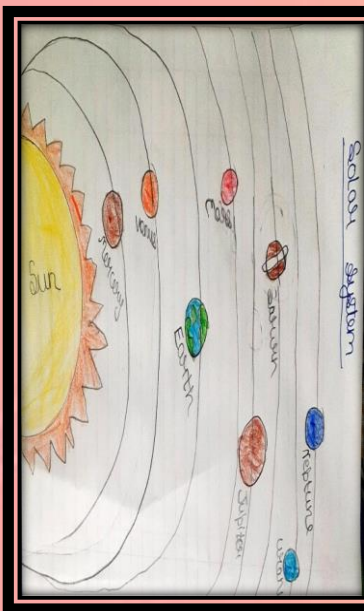
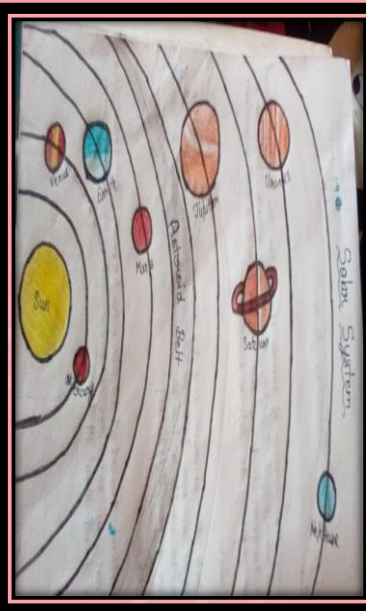
ACTIVITY

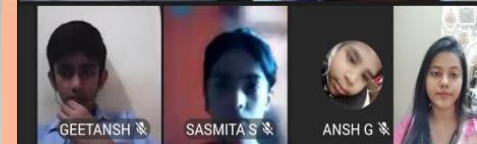
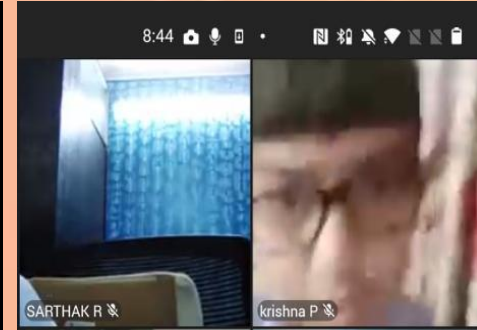
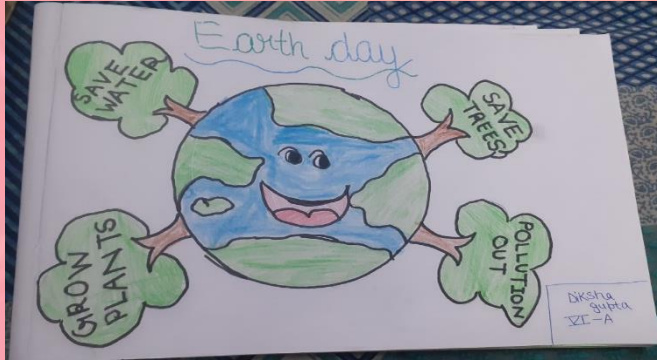
ACTIVITY ON AMBEDKAR JAYANTI
