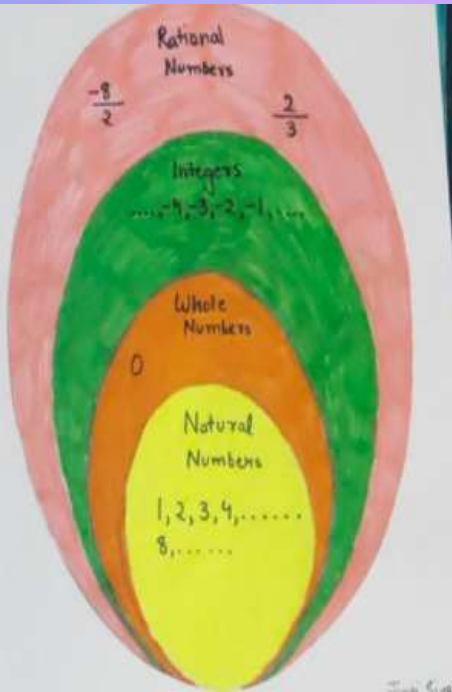
Students were asked to find the relationship between Natural numbers, Whole numbers, Integers and Rational numbers. Students participated enthusiastically.

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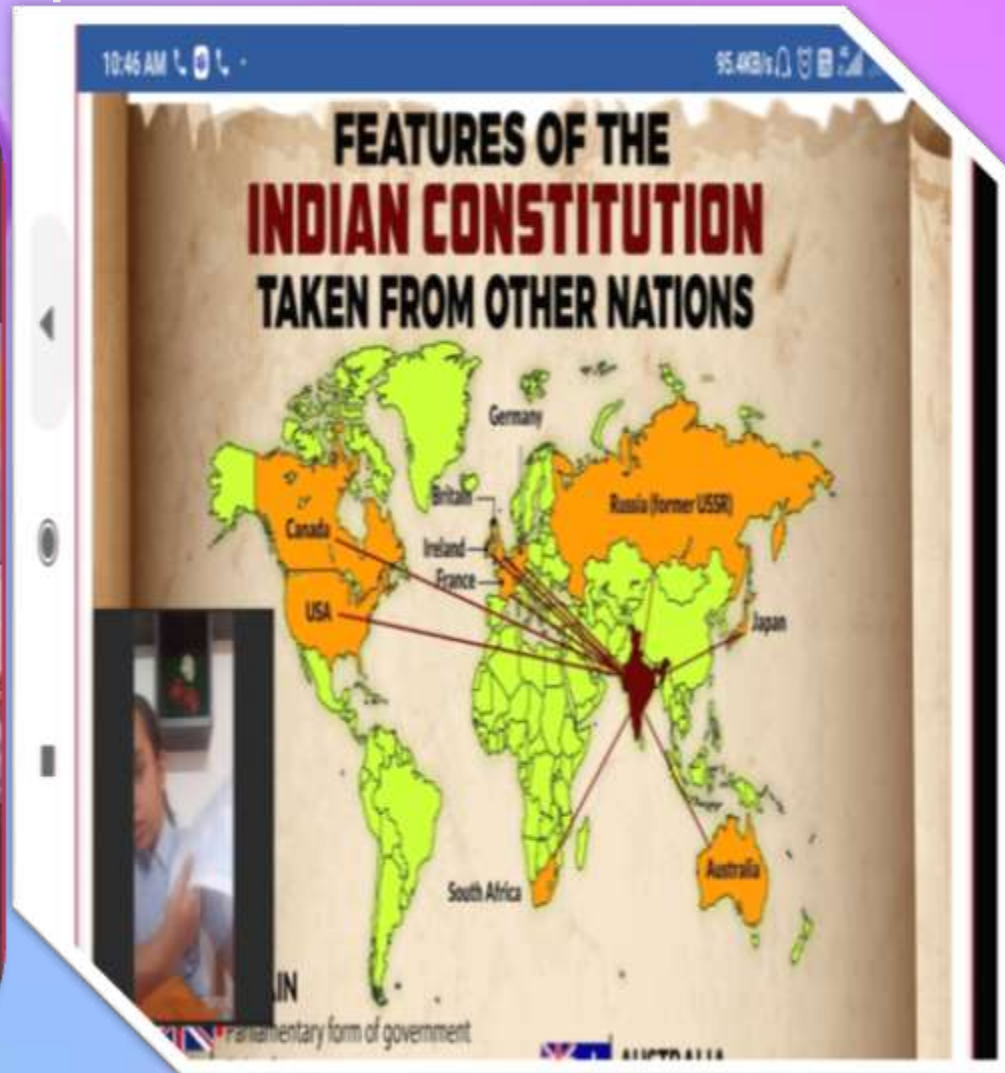
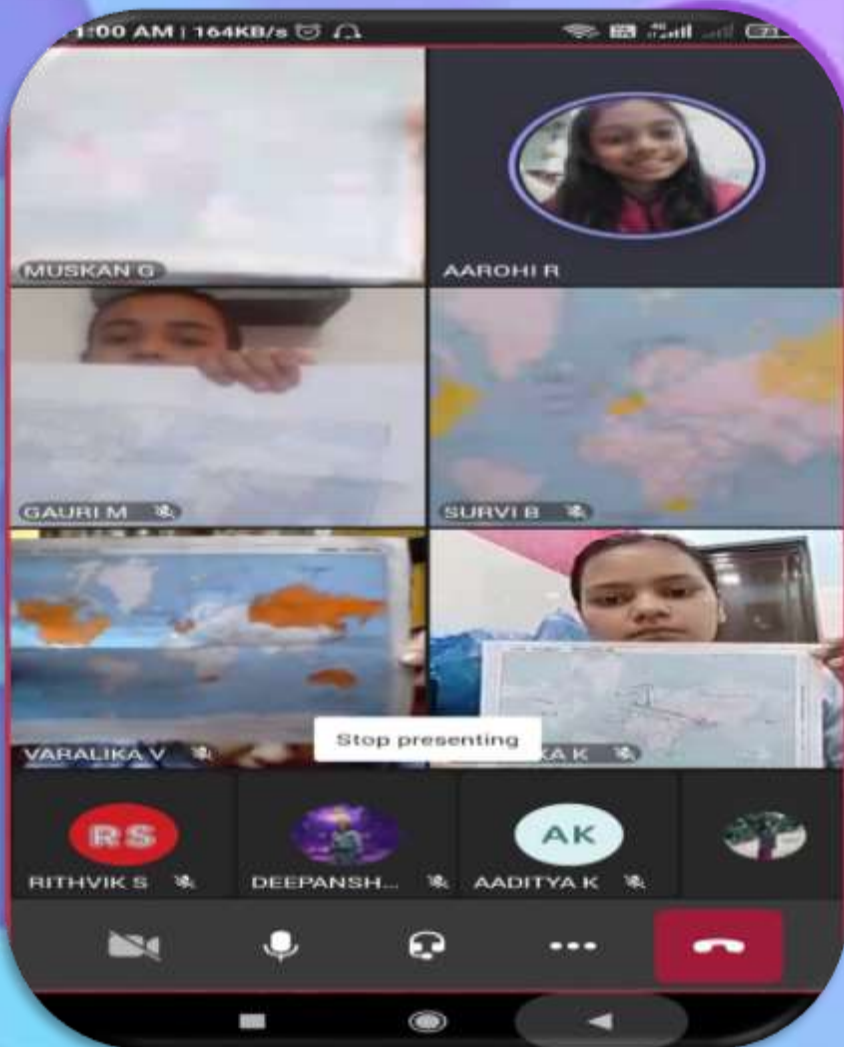

Science Experiments to give Practical Exposure to the students-A process to separate healthy seeds from unhealthy seeds.



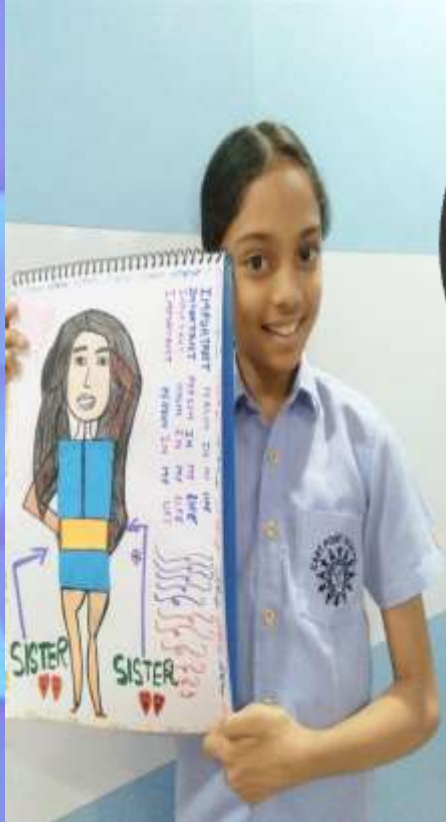

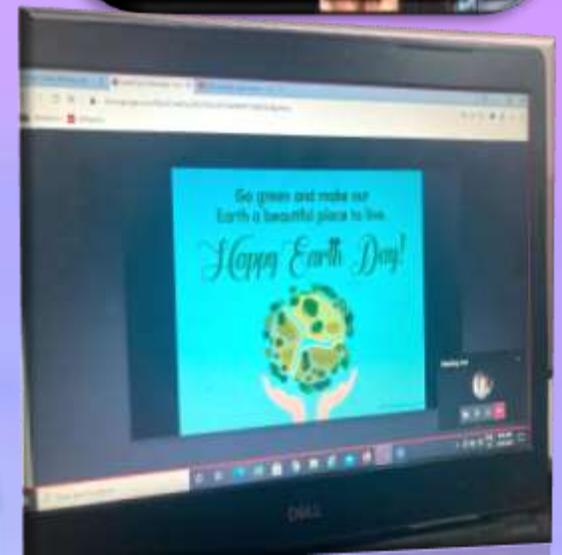
Dr.B.R.Ambedkar – Life of a Phenomenal Legend in a nutshell
 “Men are mortal. So are ideas.
 An idea needs propagation as much as plant needs watering.
 Otherwise, both will wither and die”

Powerfully quoted by Dr.Bhirm Rao Ambedkar, popularly known as Babasaheb Ambedkar was born on April 14, 1891. He was a celebrated leader and the architect of the 'Constitution of India'. He was a great statesman who fought for the rights of the Dalits, other socially backward classes and women. He went t'von to become the first law and justice minister of independent India. He was the first Indian to get a Doctorate (Ph.D.) degree in Economics from abroad. Dr.Ambedkar was a master in 64 subjects and a knowledge of 9 languages. Babasaheb is the first and only person in the world to receive a valuable doctorate degree named "Doctor All Science" from London School of Economics. Babasaheb was also an anthropologist, historian, orator, editor, prolific writer, revolutionary and a revivalist for Buddhism in India. While working on women empowerment he emphatically quoted "I measure the progress of a community by the Degree of progress, which women have achieved". Dr.Ambedkar passed away in Delhi on December 6, 1956. He was posthumously awarded India's highest civilian award, the Bharat Ratna in 1990.

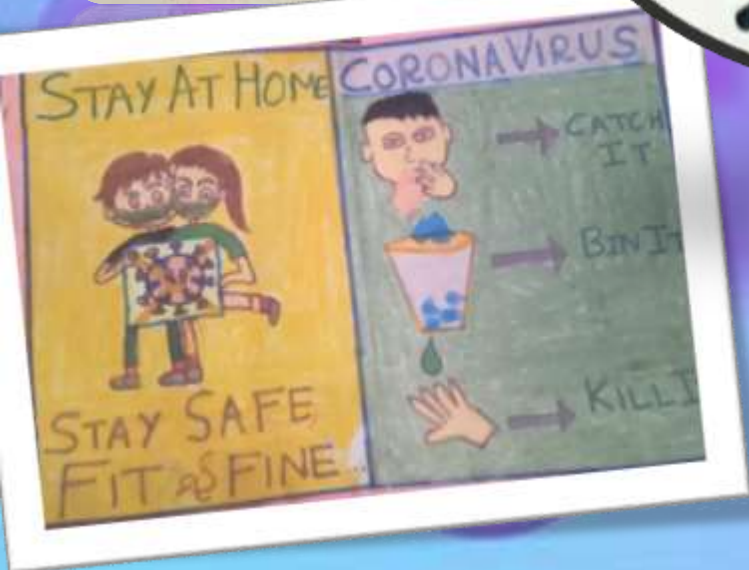
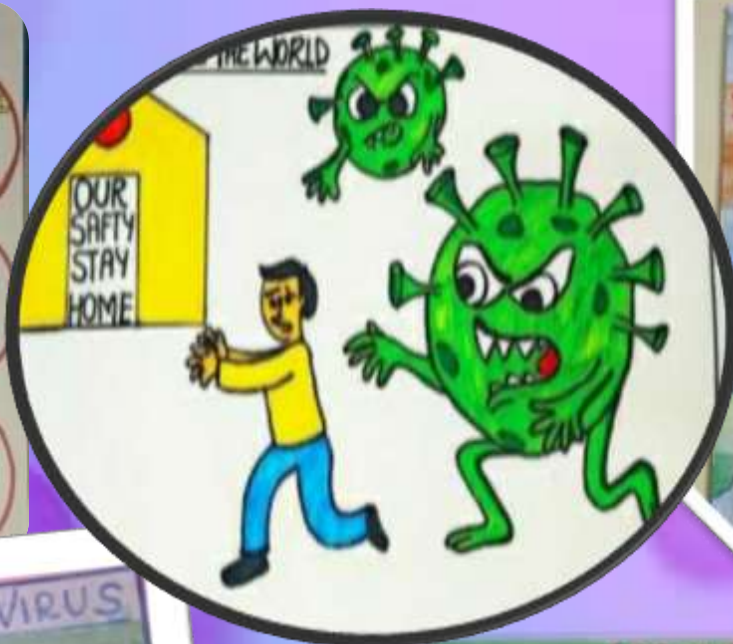
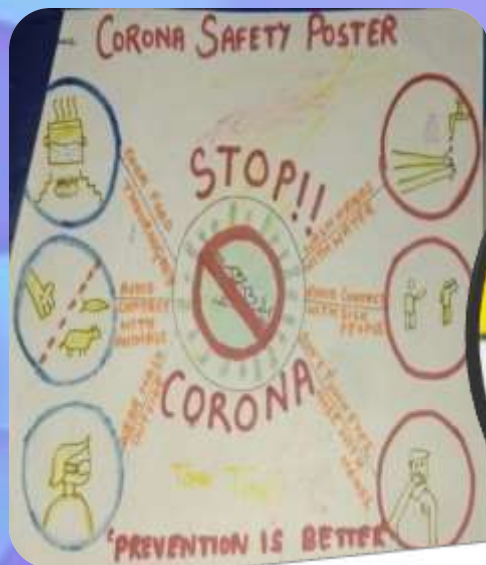
