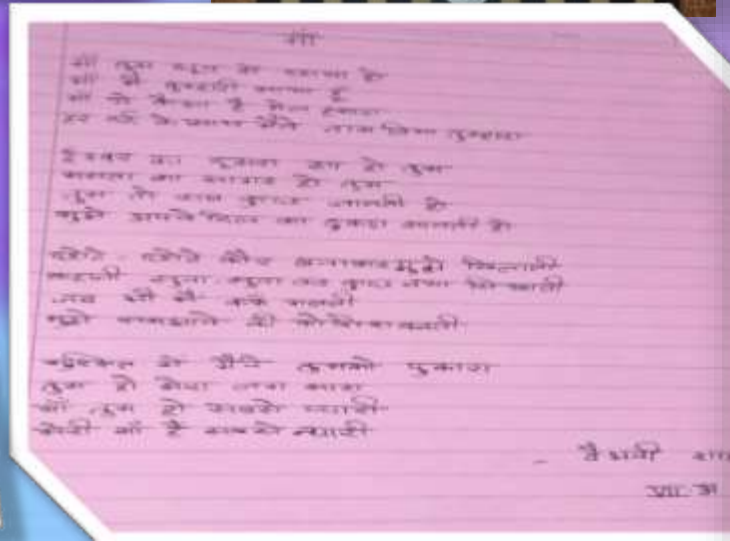
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The students learnt a self composed song on Mother's Day and also special Antakshri competition was played between the boys and the girls.


