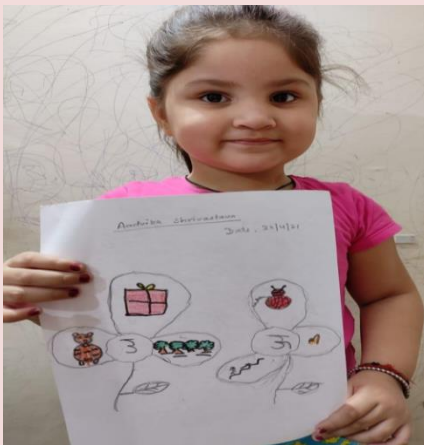
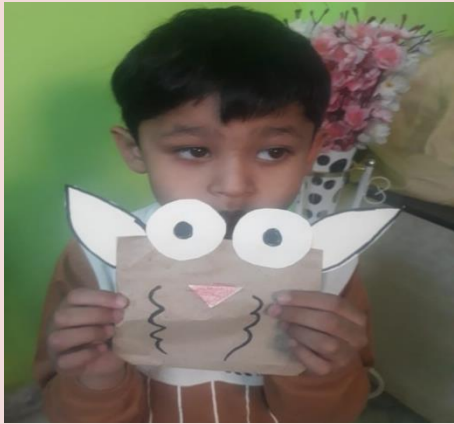
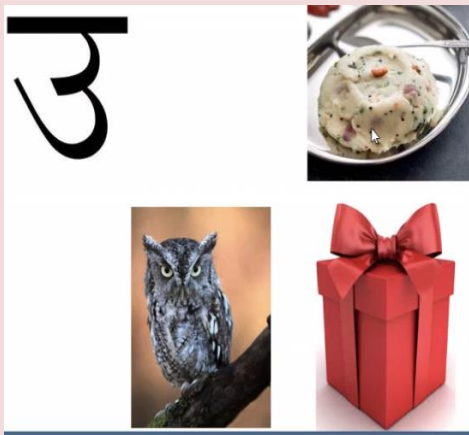
Tiny tots of KG had shown their talent in rhyme recitation activity using props during summer capsule program .

- For formation learning they traced Swar 'uu' using dry flour.

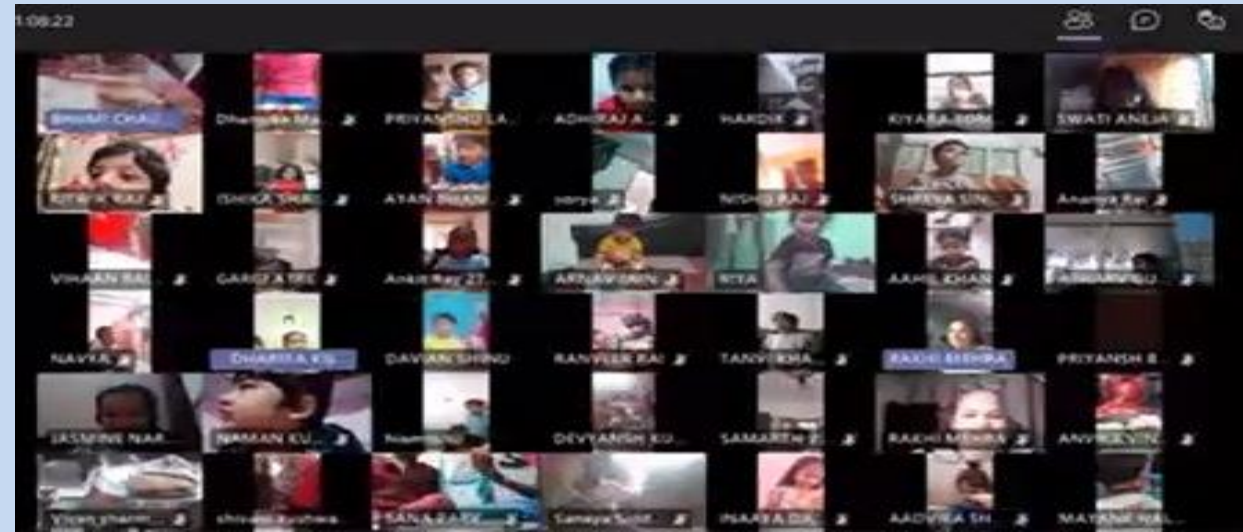




“During summer the nature is at its full bloom and fruits and flowers abound”.

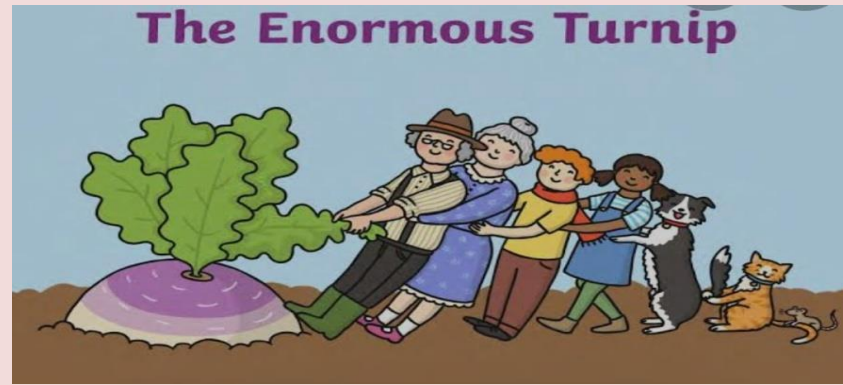
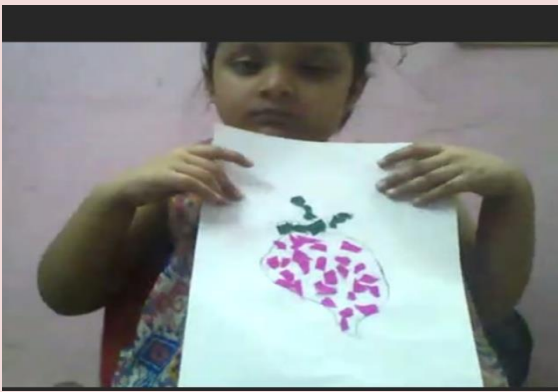

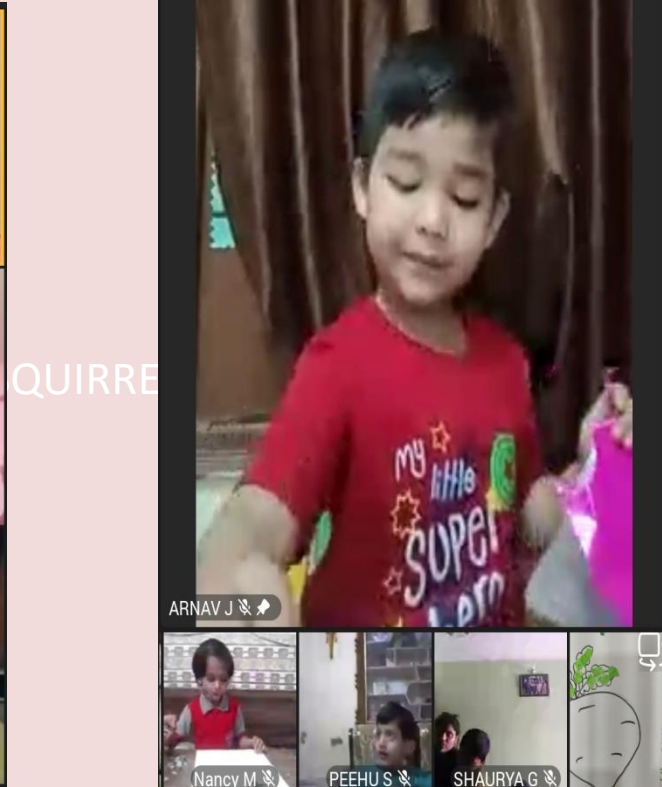

Mother's Day Celebration

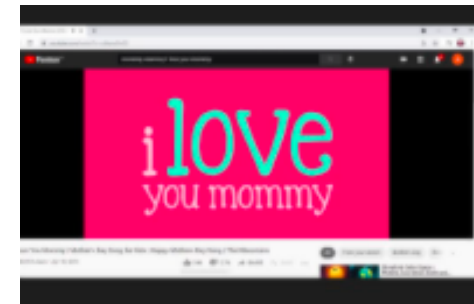
- ❖ To celebrate the bond of love between mother and child, Mother's Day was celebrated on 7th May by KG children.

- ❖ Every section of KG showed a special video of children with mother – received positive appreciation.



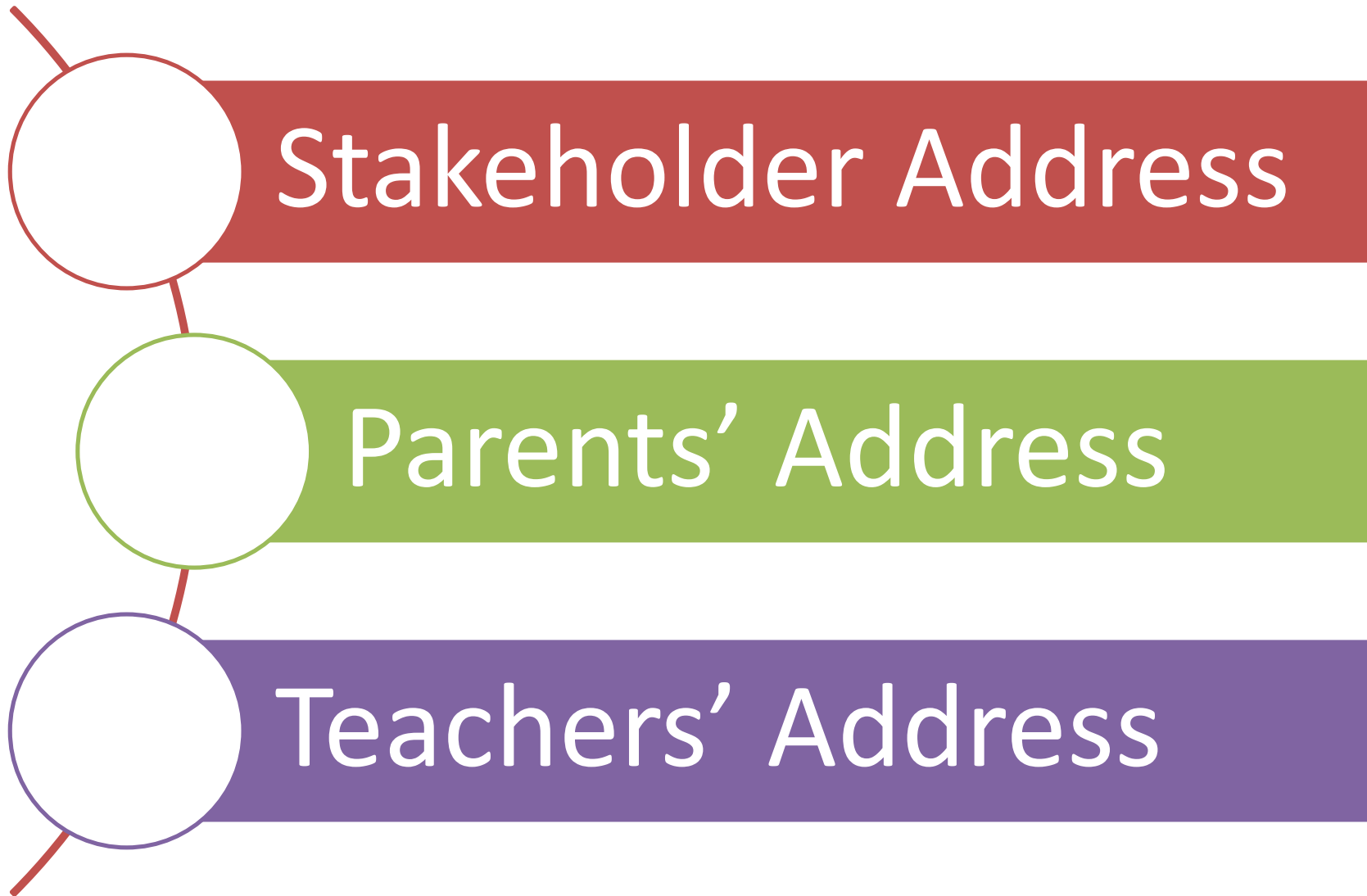
