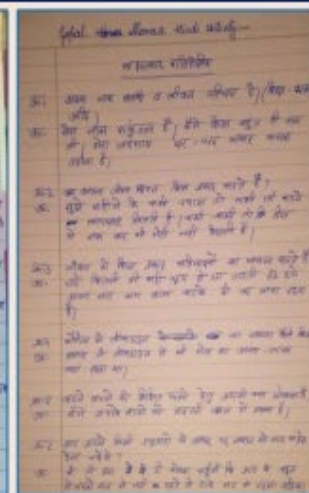
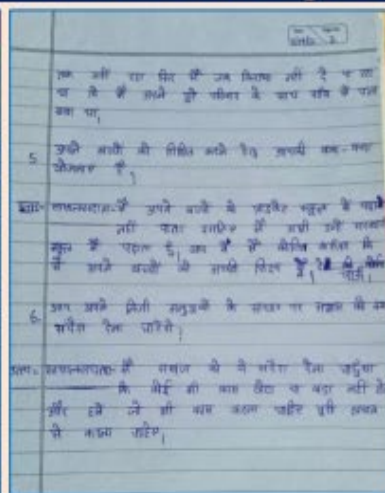
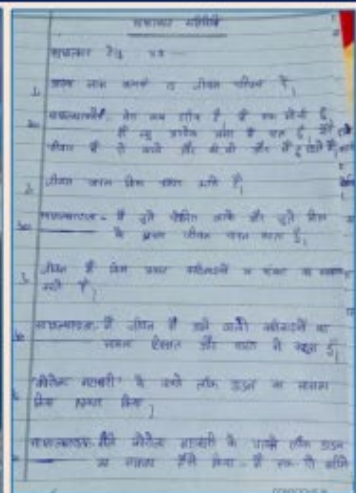

BASED ON THIS ARTICLE A FEW QUESTIONS WERE BEING ASKED FROM THE STUDENTS. A PROPER DISCUSSION WAS HELD AS TO HOW TO TACKLE WITH THIS PROBLEM OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN RURAL AREAS AND WHAT WERE THE IMPORTANT STEPS TAKEN BY THE GOVERNMENT TO DEAL WITH IT.

Q1. What is the full form of MGNREGS ?
 Ans. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act.

Q2. What is the impact of COVID - 19 on the employment generation under MGNREGS in both rural and urban areas ?
 Ans. Due to the lockdown, there was no work for workers. So there was a huge demand for work. In April 2020, 2 crore people were demanding work but in May it jumped to 5.2 crore. Thus, more unemployment. The aim was to give working days of 100 but it decreased to 48.51 days.

Q3. Explain the concept of Wage employment ?
 Ans. Wage employment is a kind of agreement from the employer (who gives the work) that at least some one at particular time he will be providing the work and wages for the employee. And in MGNREGS, it is mandate to provide at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment to rural workers.

Q4. Explain the likely impact of the employment generation under MGNREGS scheme on the poverty levels of India ?
 Ans. An amount of ₹ 98,413 crore has been spent in the scheme and ₹ 73,000 crore has been distributed. It reduced the poverty levels in India. Given work to unemployed, not to all but something is better than nothing. And it is not possible to provide work to all. It has prevented 4 million people from falling into poverty. It has given an opportunity to people (rural workers) to earn for their families and to own their livelihood. Women were also benefited from MGNREGS.

Q5. Name some of the other Poverty alleviation programmes launched by the Indian government to tackle the situation of poverty ?
 Ans. (i) National Old Age Pension Scheme (NOAPS)
 (ii) Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojna (PMJDY)
 (iii) National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS)

 Due to the introduction of Covid-19 in the country, the number of unemployed people increased both in rural and urban areas.

Q3. Explain the concept of Wage employment ?
 Rural workers who are their own employment are eligible to be employed under MGNREGS. Under this act, the government provides employment to rural people and pays for them accordingly for their work. This is called wage employment.

Q4. Explain the likely impact of the employment generation under MGNREGS scheme on the poverty levels of India.
 The fall of in economic activities have created enough jobs in urban areas and that a section of rural labourers were returned to them that had been in search of any job.

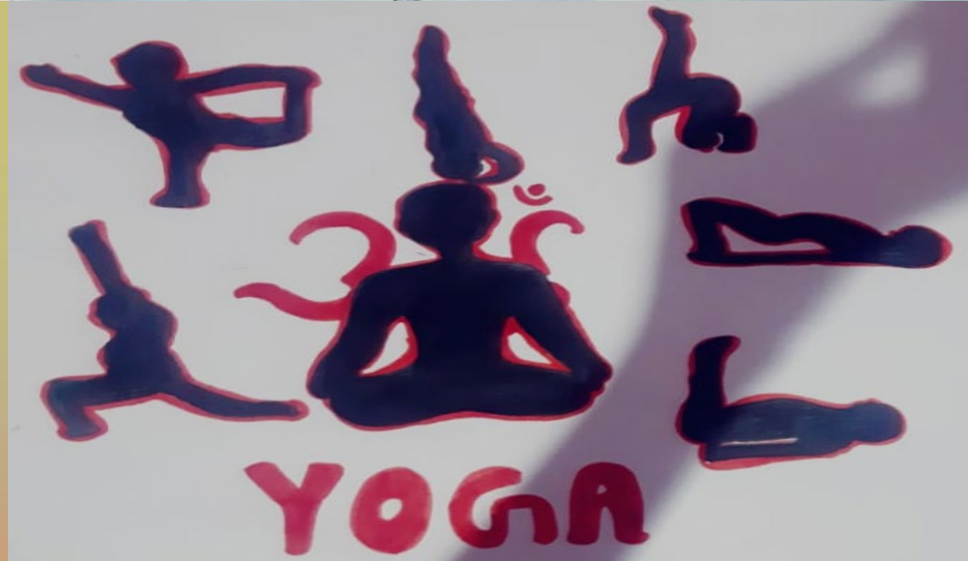

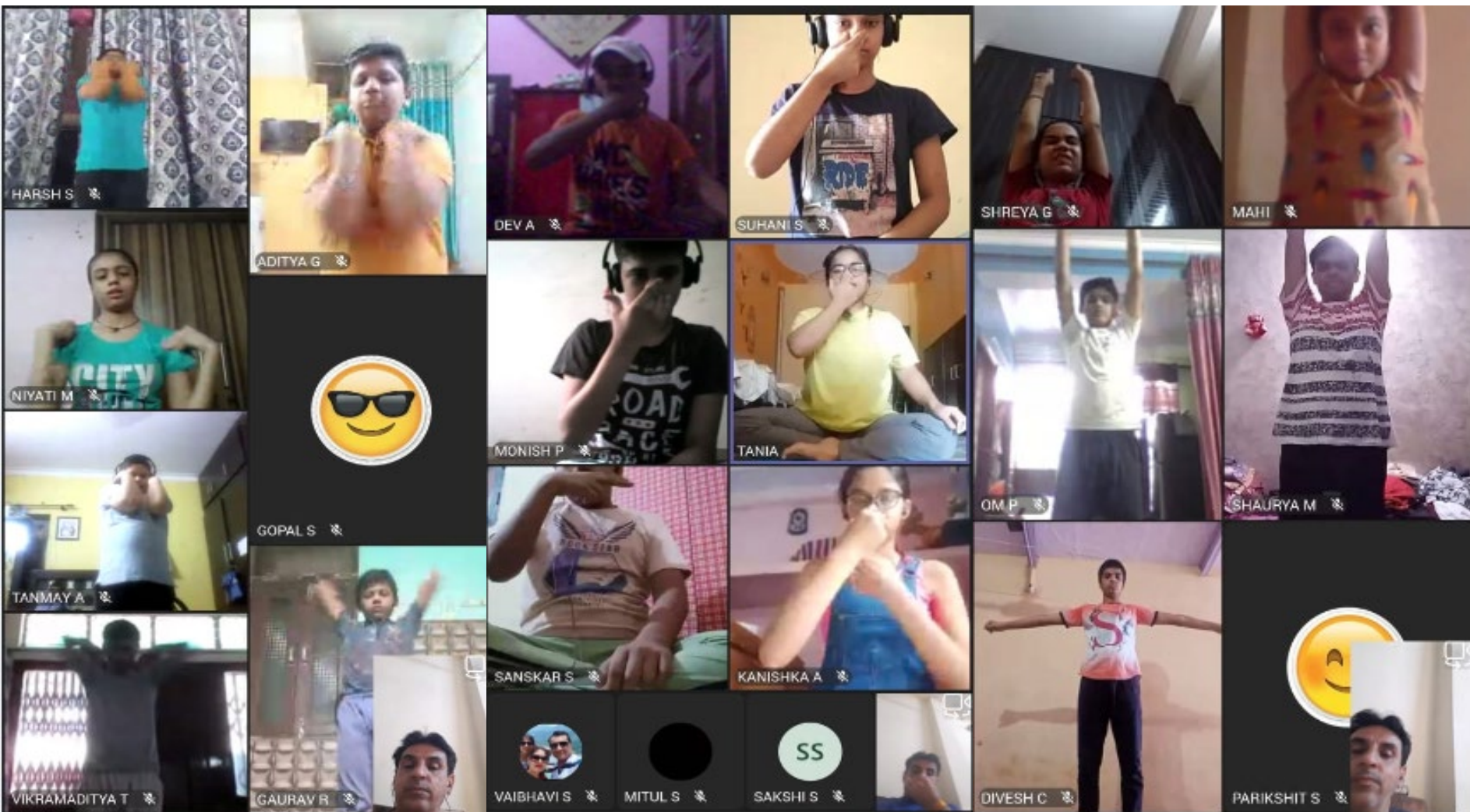

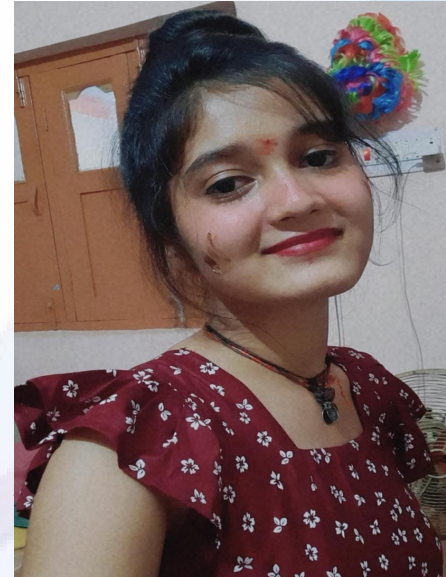
