
A brief introduction of Epic Poetry was given and Epics like the Ramyana, the Mahabharata and the Illiad were introduced to them.


















PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASS-XII



ACTIVITY.1

As we all know that respiration is a common process of exhaling and inhaling gases. In activity 1 we have to take a round balloon and stretch it out. Take a deep breath and then exhale into the balloon. Pinch the end of the balloon and measure its diameter in cm. Learning outcome-Measuring breath inhaling and exhaling capacity to understand the functioning capacity of your lungs by using a Balloon. It also measures your tidal volume. It is a way of measuring human lung capacity. Students did it for 5 times and found themself tired.









ACTIVITY .2

Stand in straight posture on toes, close your eyes, stretch your arms straight above your head.

Maintain this position for 10 seconds.

Now, open your eyes and maintain same posture for next ten seconds.

ELECTROCHEMICAL CELLS

What is an Electrochemical Cell?


An electrochemical cell is a device that can generate electrical energy from the chemical reactions occurring in it, or use the electrical energy supplied to it to facilitate chemical reactions in it. These devices are capable of converting chemical energy into electrical energy, or vice versa.

Such cells capable of generating an electric current from the chemical reactions occurring in them care called <u>Galvanic cells</u> or Voltaic cells. Alternatively, the cells which cause chemical reactions to occur in them when an electric current is passed through them are called electrolytic cells.





Single electrode cell (half-cell)



In the beginning, both these changes occur with different speeds but soon an equilibrium is established.

If first effect is greater than the second, the metal acquires a negative charge with respect to solution and




