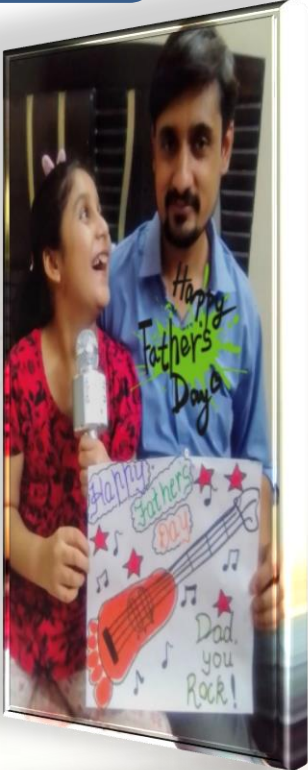
To develop motor skills, the children get involved in warm up exercises. They also understood the importance of Yoga and celebrated the yoga day with enthusiasm.

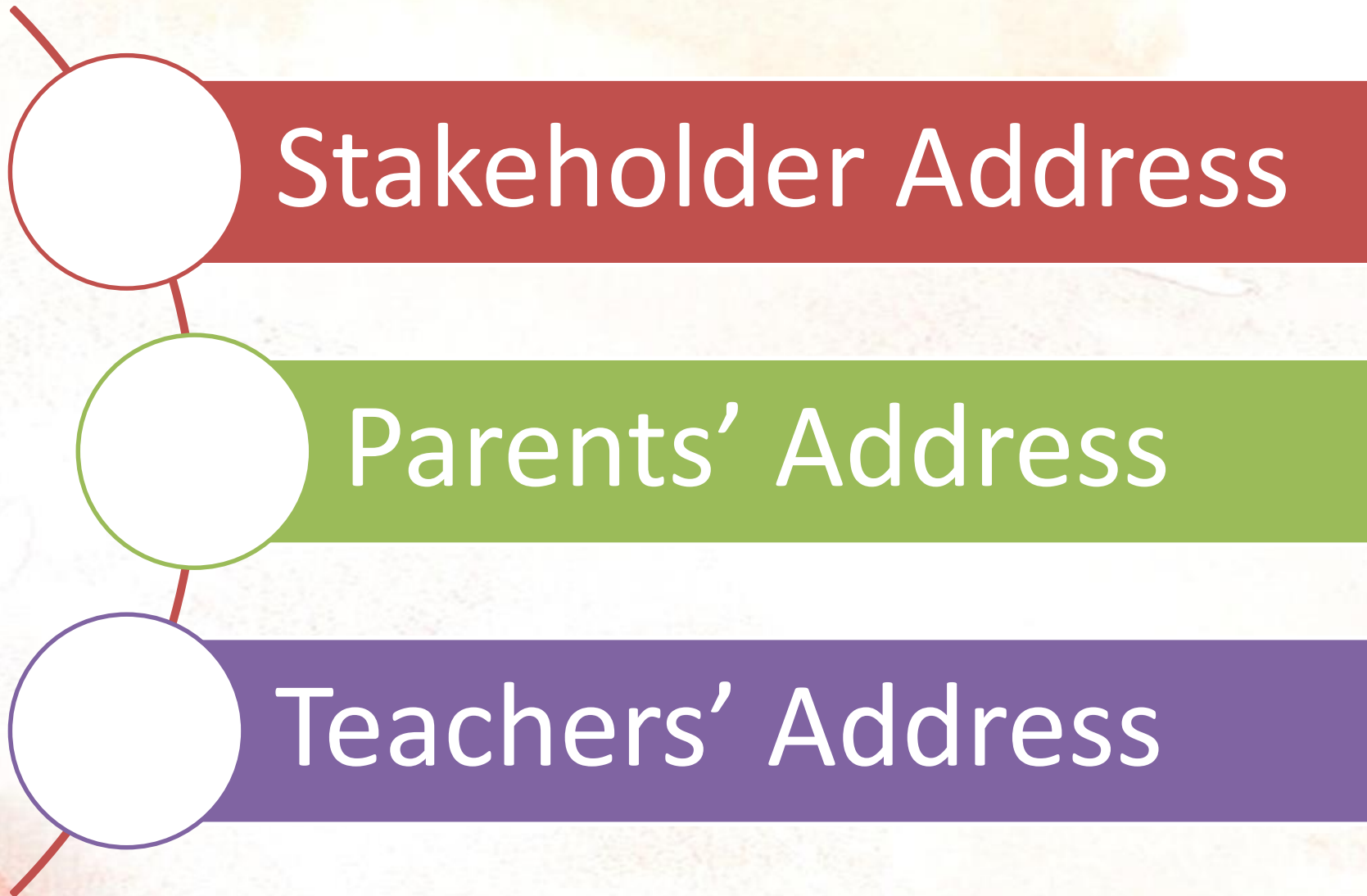
