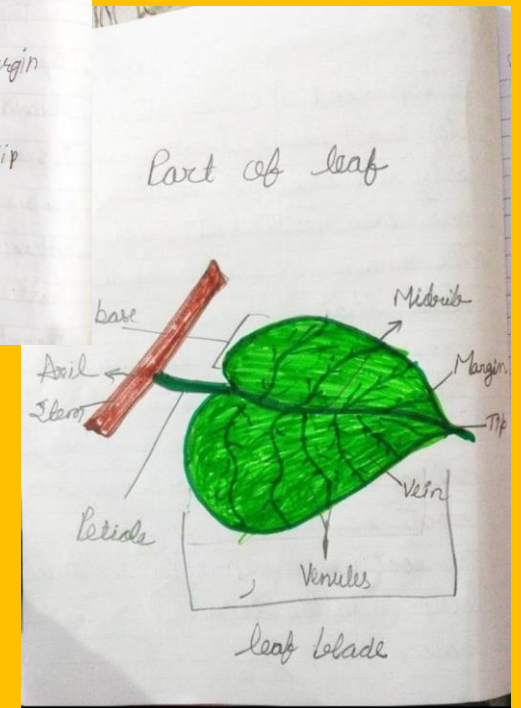
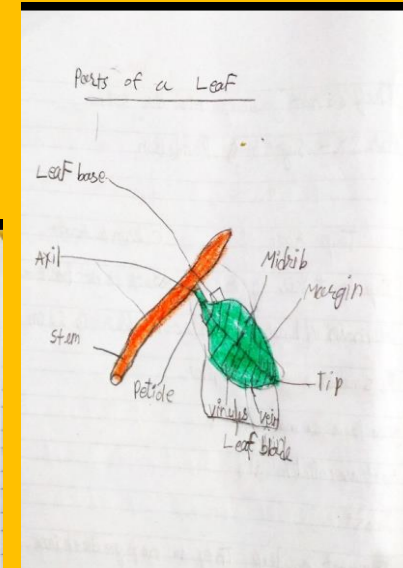
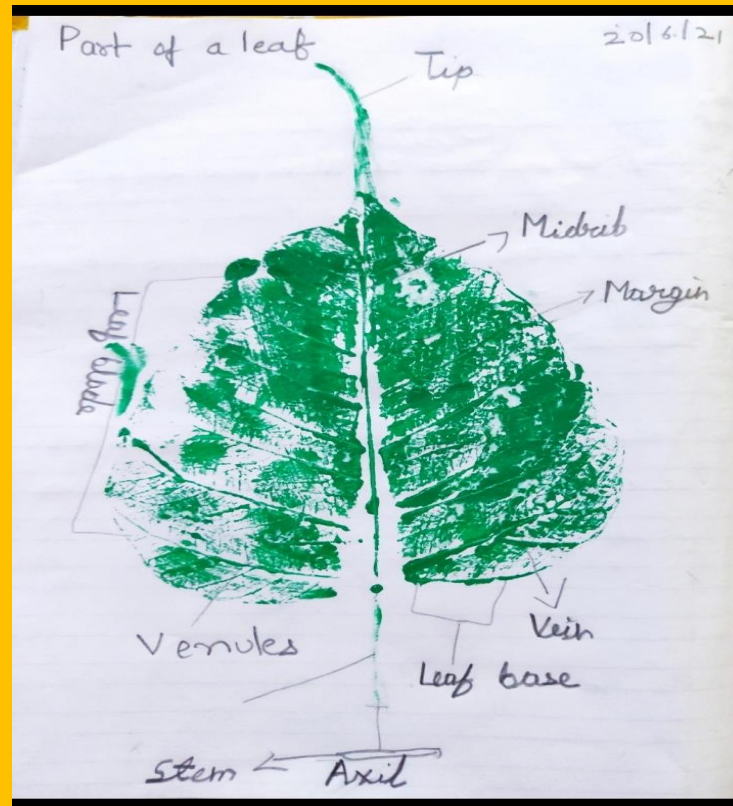
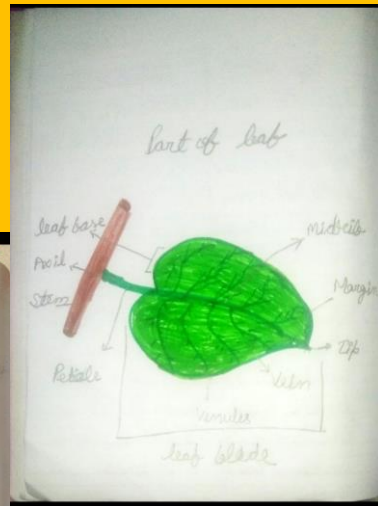
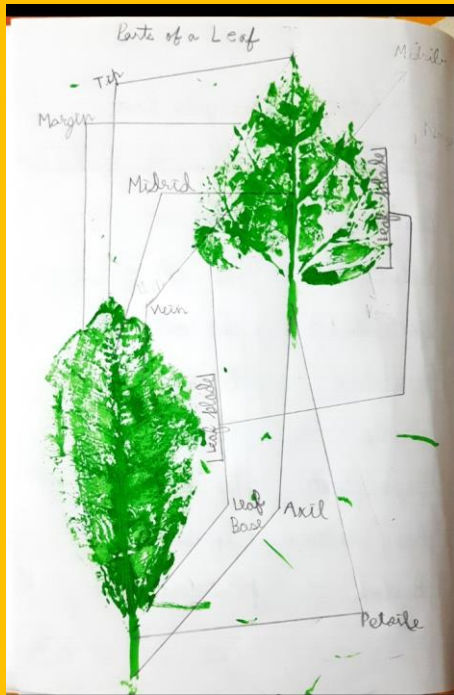
MODEL MAKING ON EXPANDED FORM AND PLACE VALUE FORM

Students willingly took part in Model making activity and were able to show expanded form of any number using the model too.

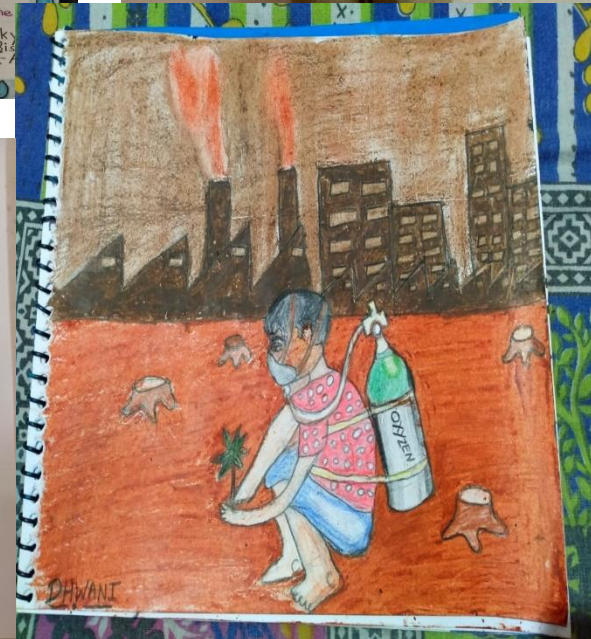
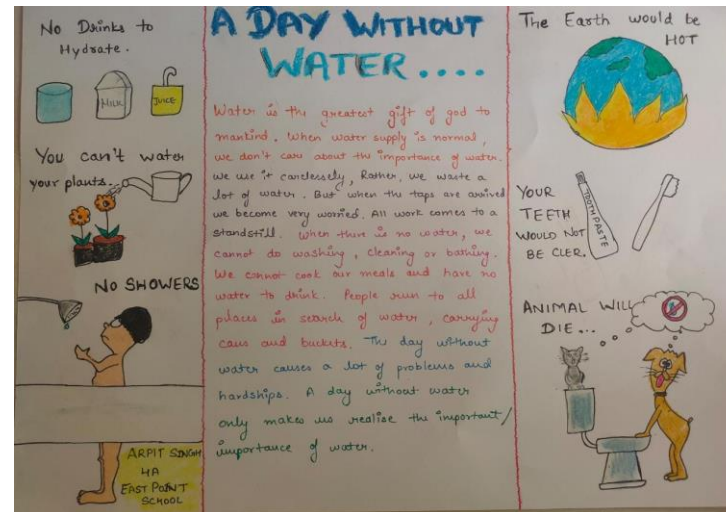
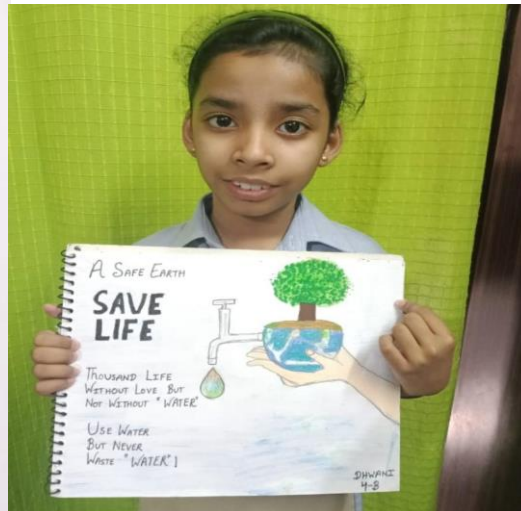
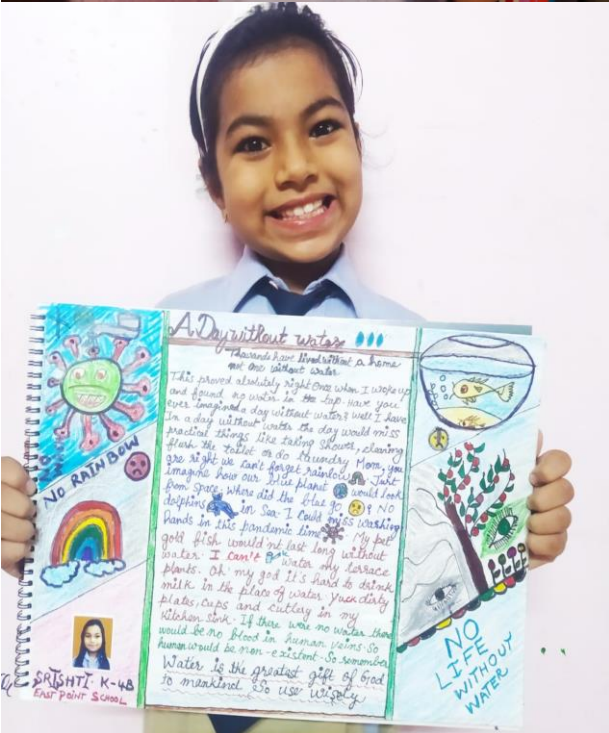
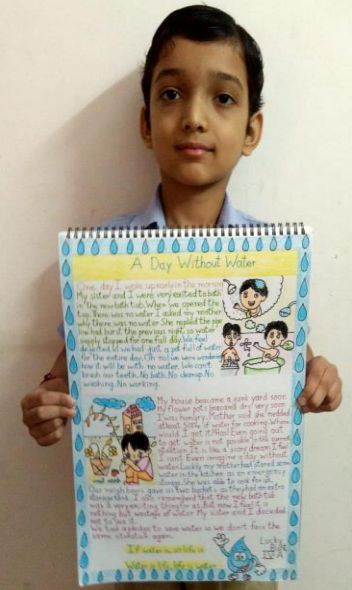
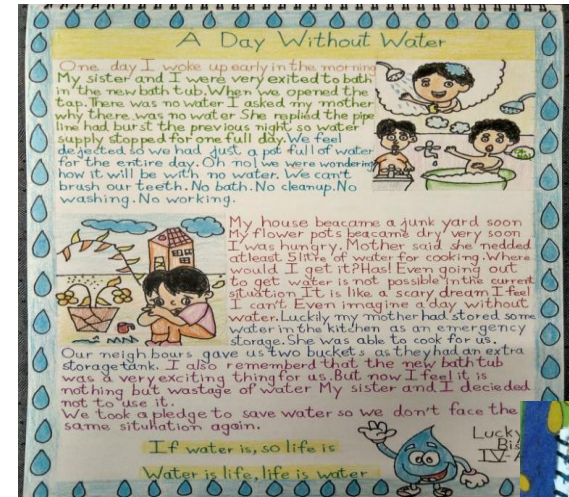
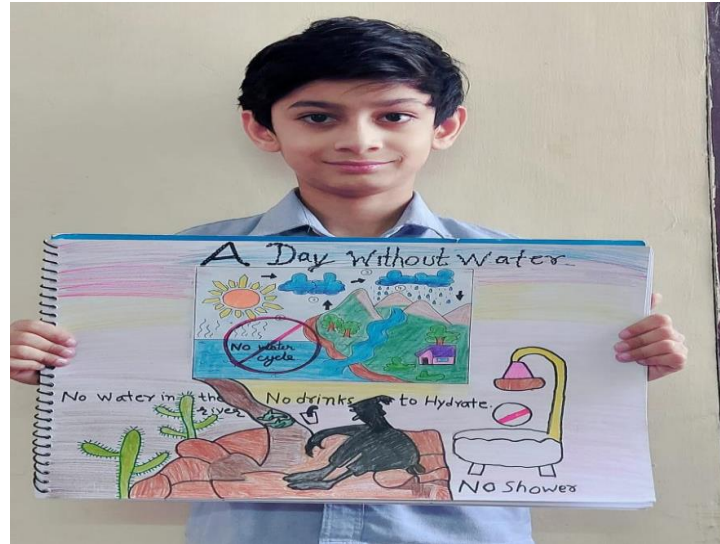

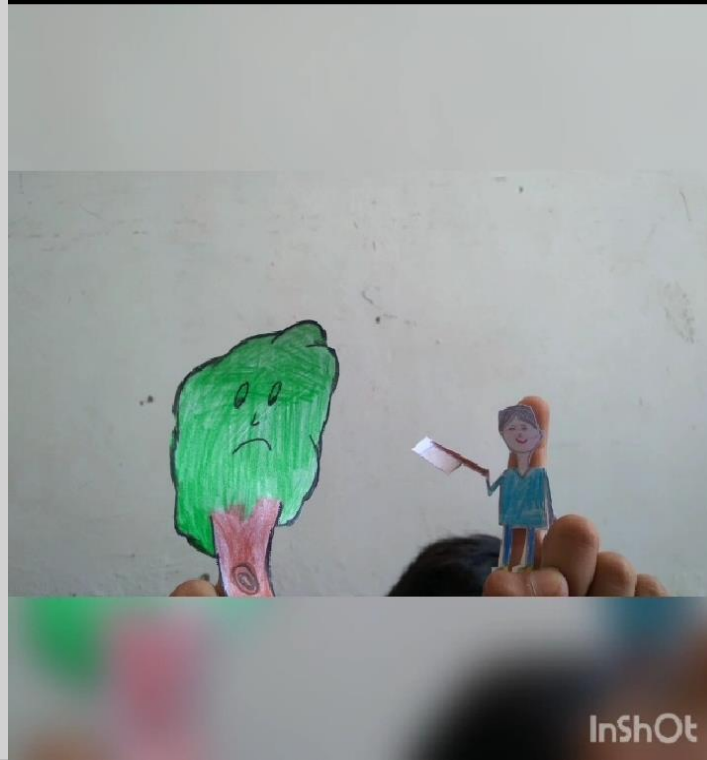
'Seed Boom activity' It's a technique of planting trees by embedding organic seed balls in the ground. It is also known as arial reforestation.



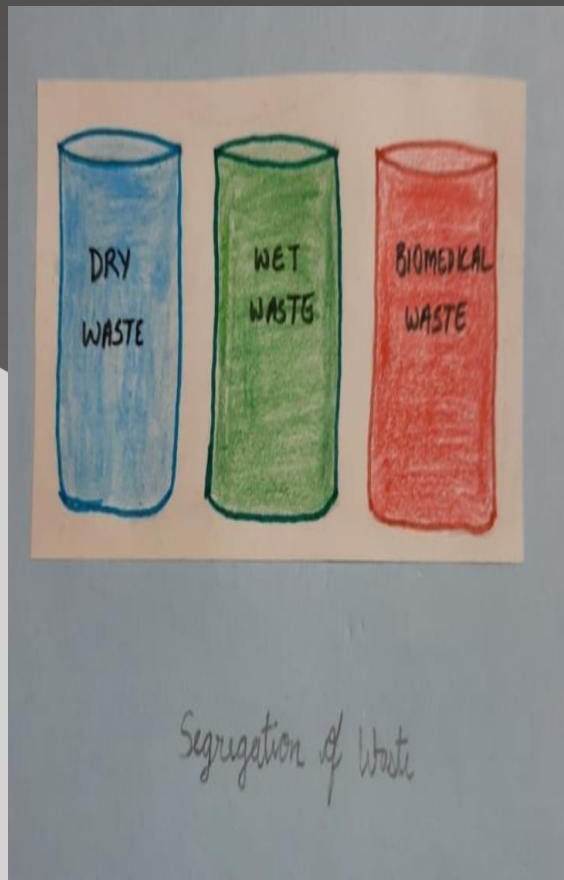
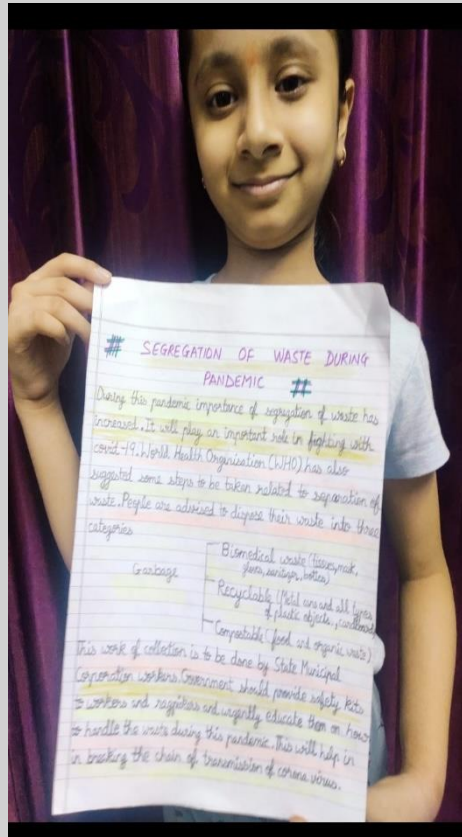

Segregation of Waste During Pandemic

Today the whole world is fighting with covid-19. India already has a stressed waste management system and the Covid-19 pandemic has further burdened it. In addition to the general solid waste, now tonnes of biomedical waste is also being produced. Mixing of the general solid waste and biomedical waste results in additional load on recycling them. If the waste gets properly segregated at the source and managed properly, the burden on environment can be reduced. The masks and gloves used by the people should be cut and kept in paper bags for a minimum of 72 hours before discarding as general solid waste. Reusable masks, gloves and other PPEs can also help reduce waste burden. There is a need to spread awareness among people.
