वर्णमाला- हिंदी वर्णमाला स्वर और व्यंजन हैं। वर्णों के व्यवस्थित रूप क्रमबद्ध समूह को वर्णमाला कहते हैं। कुछ अन्य ध्वनियाँ हिंदी भाषा में प्रयोग होती हैं।

अनुस्वार (-ँ) - अनुस्वार नमक होता है। जैसे-कंठ, सं, ङित, रांगा आदि।

आगत ध्वनियाँ - विदेशी भाषा के प्रभाव से हिंदी में भी प्रयोग होता है।

उर्णो - अंग्रेजी के शब्द बनकर हिंदी में प्रयोग किया जाता है; जैसे-कॉन्टर, टॉफेंसिट आदि।

अर्ण और फ - अरबी व फारसी भाषा के प्रभाव से हिंदी भाषा में प्रयोग होता है; जैसे-जसोन, वर्क, नैटफा आदि।

How Planting Trees Can Help in Reducing Pollution

- 1) Trees absorb odors and pollutant gases (nitrogen oxides, ammonia, sulfur dioxide & ozone) & filter particulates out of the air by trapping them on their leaves & bark.
- 2) Trees help clean our air.
- 3) Trees remove pollution from the atmosphere, improving air quality & human health.

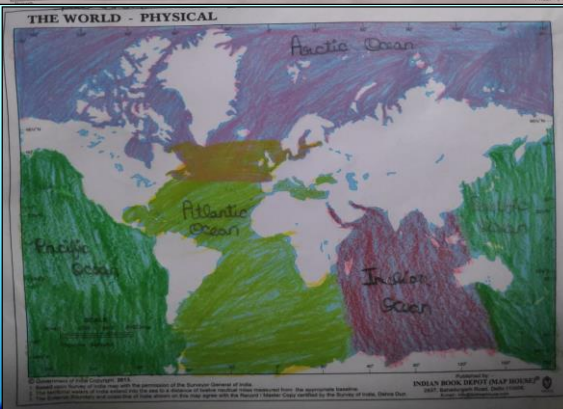
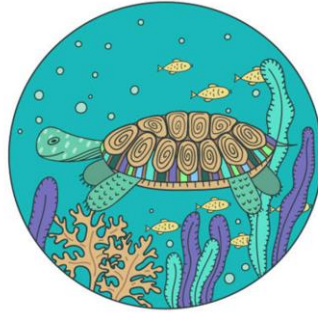
The plants absorb the pollution in its leaves.

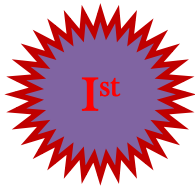

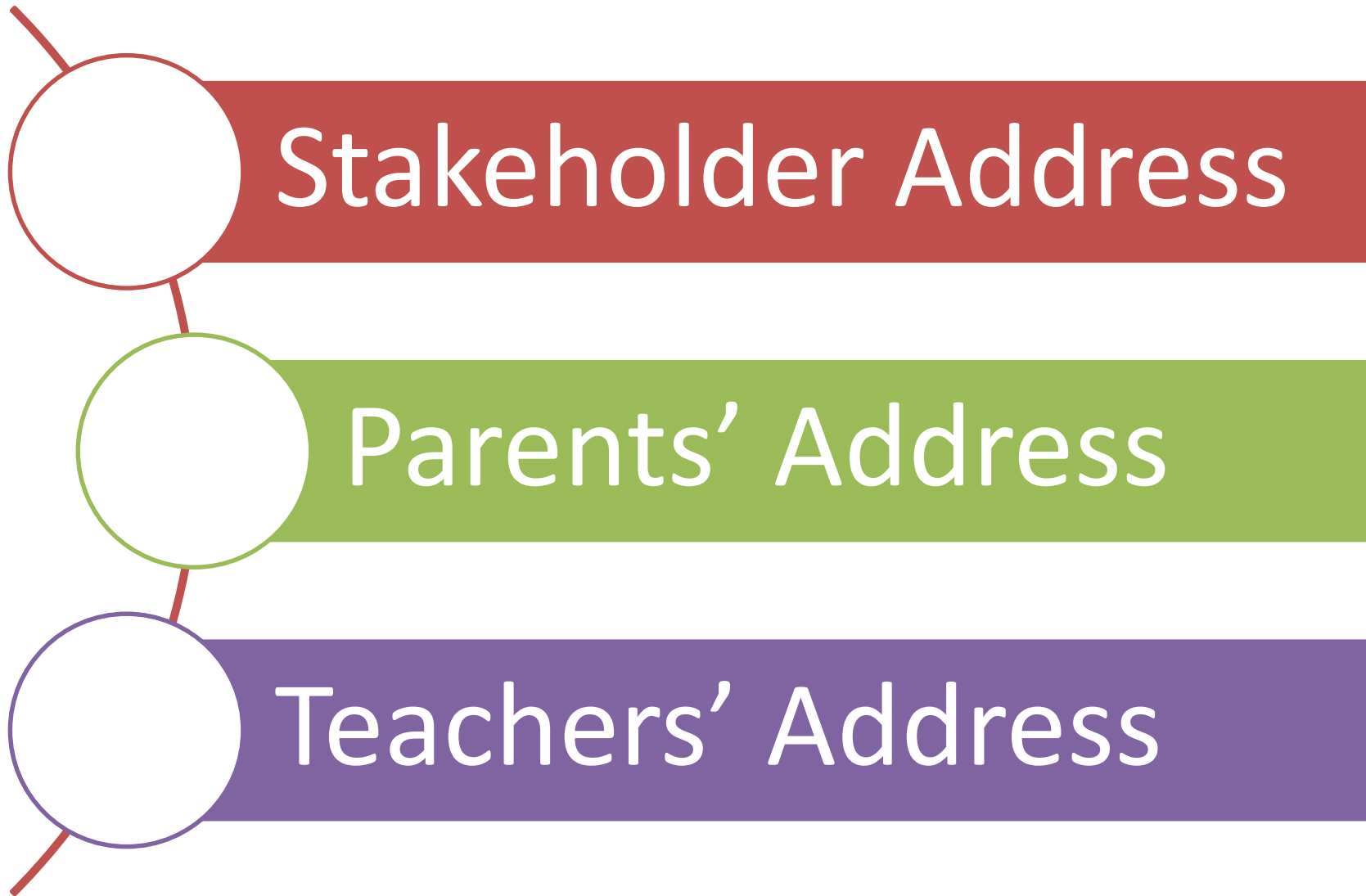

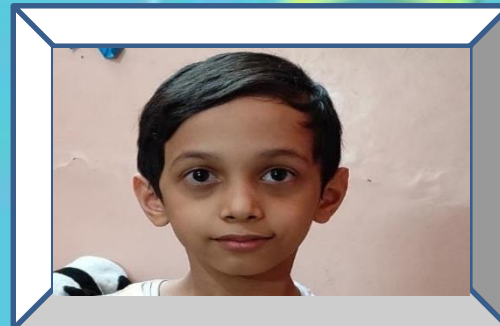
