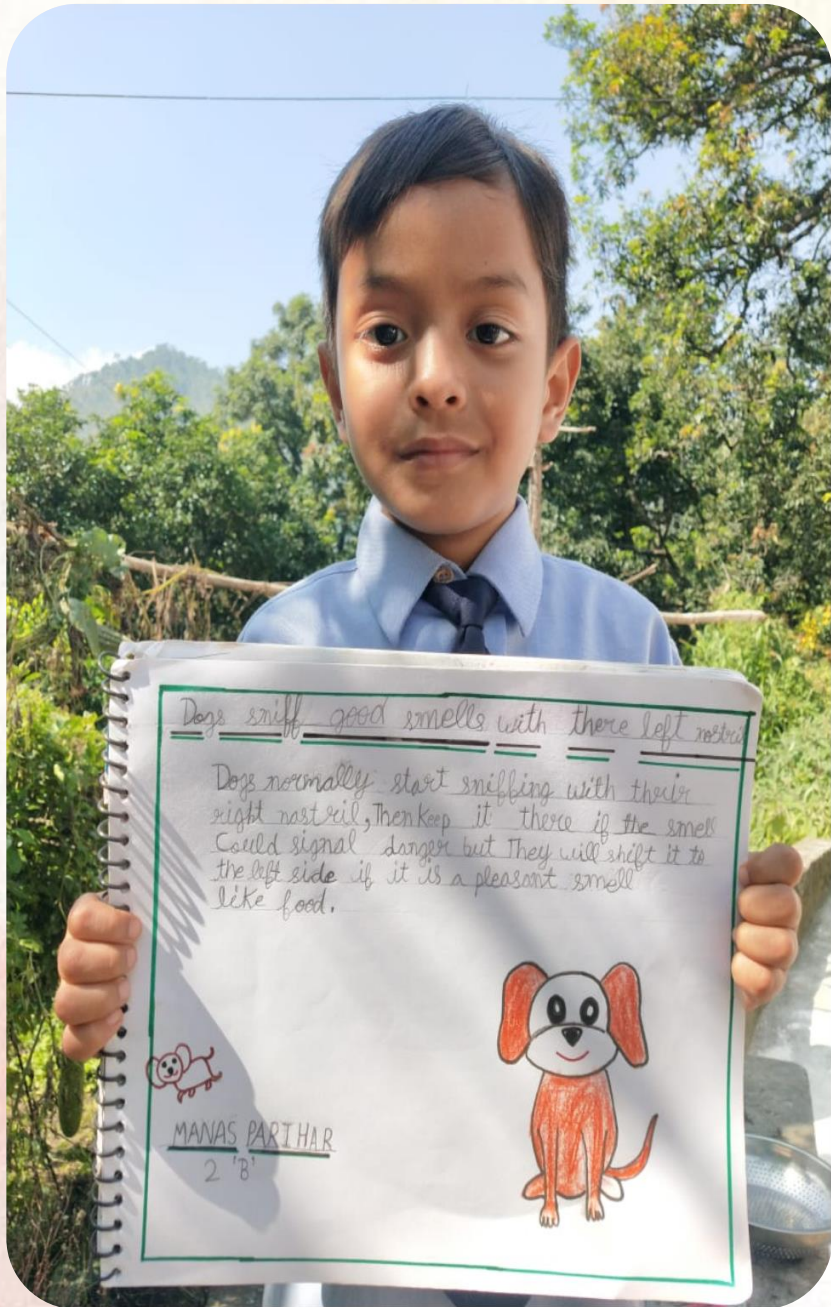


Morning Assembly

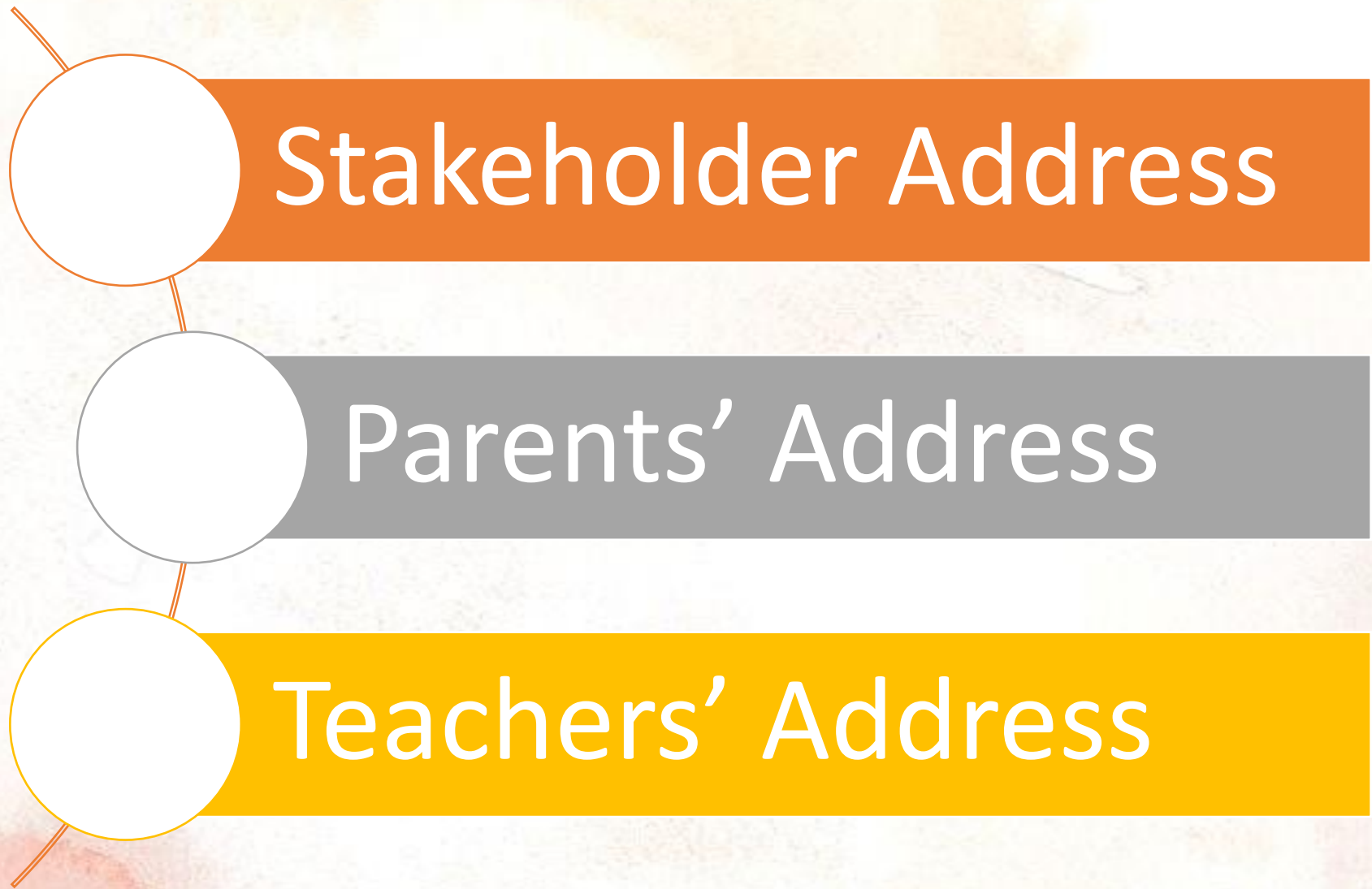

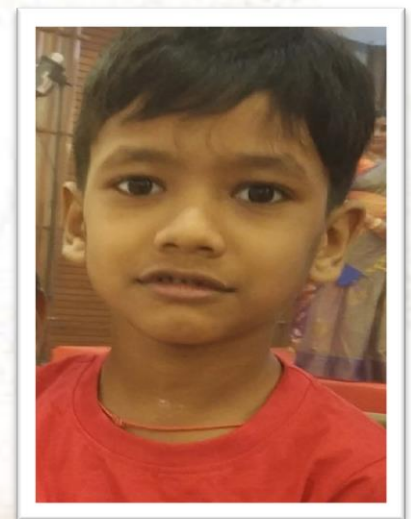
