


Concept of measurement of length and weight was explained through various hands on activities. Students are now aware about various Non standard and Standard units used to measure length and weight.





The morning assemblies are held to instil values The children learnt the virtues of honesty and truth. They understood the importance of following this value in their lives for a righteous living.
















Dogs sniff good smells with there left mestrice
