

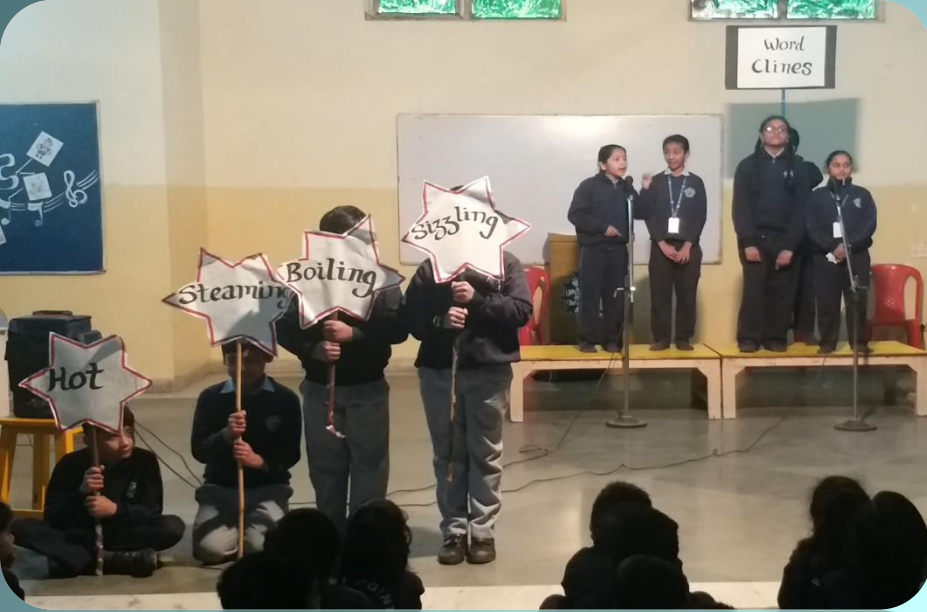

**Students of class IV collect vegetable peels on a daily basis for composting. This practice turns vegetable peels into manure and is a first step towards segregating waste.**





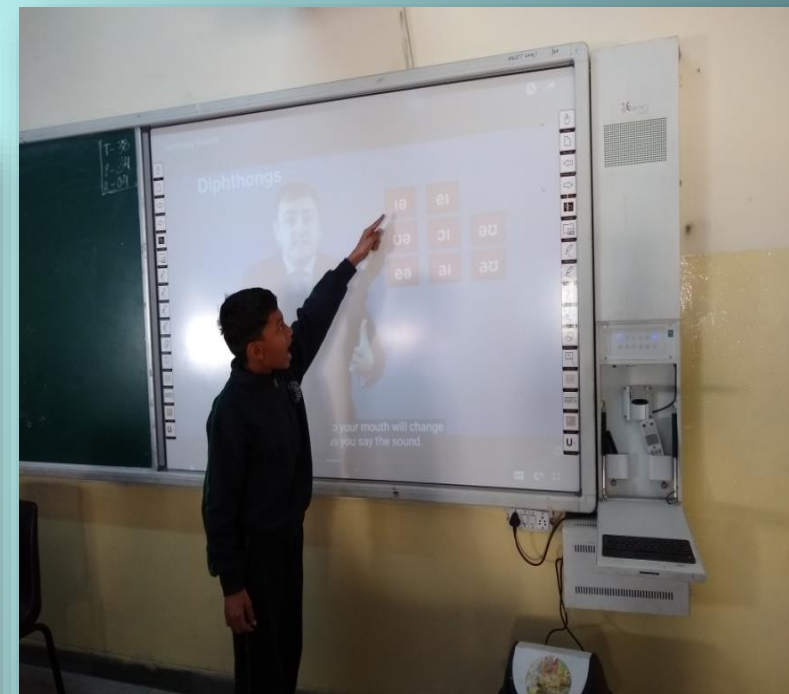
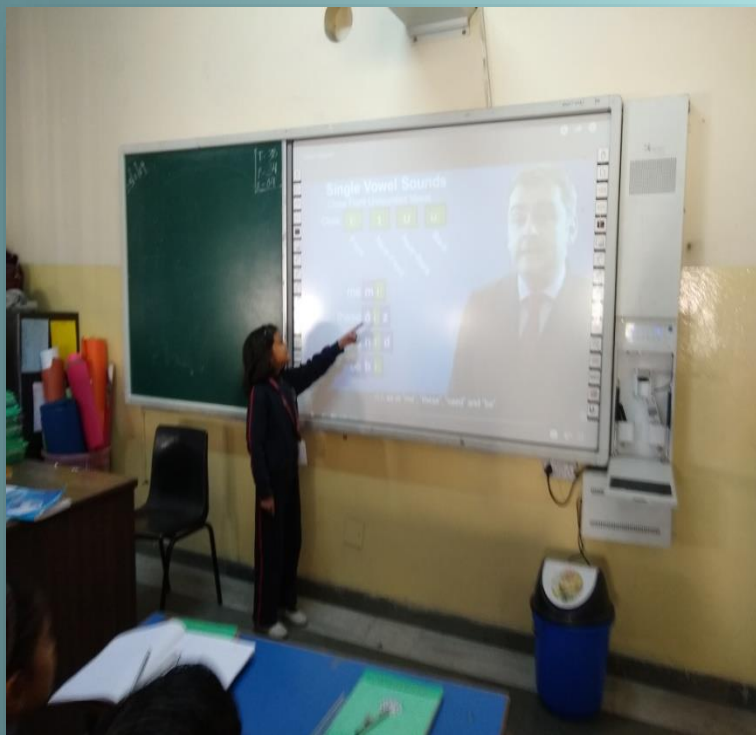
## Nature- My first school..
