


Show and Tell








Keeping Clean Activity

Keeping clean topic was explained to class 2 students in which students were told to draw a picture of a body and the things used to clean various body parts. It was a fun activity which was thoroughly enjoyed by the students.







During Maths week children were given paper cut-outs of various 2D shapes. They used it to identify the number of sides and corners of each shape. To understand the projection of 3D shape on a plain surface, children traced solid shapes to get plain shapes. They also combined different shapes to represent from the surrounding.
