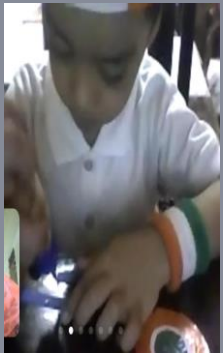

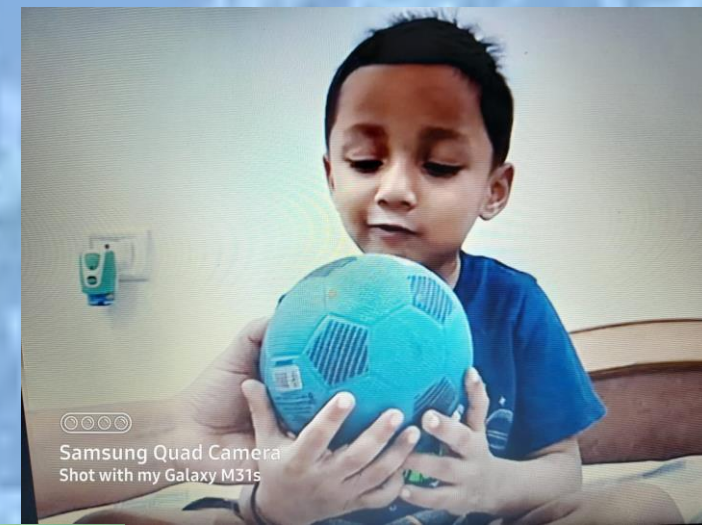


INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

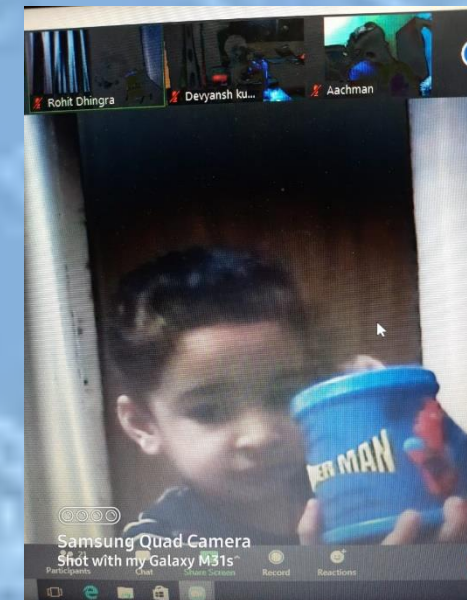
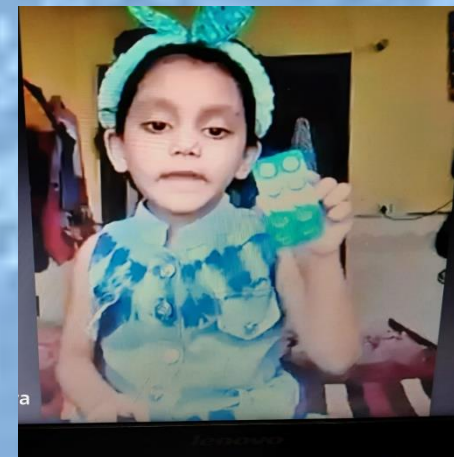
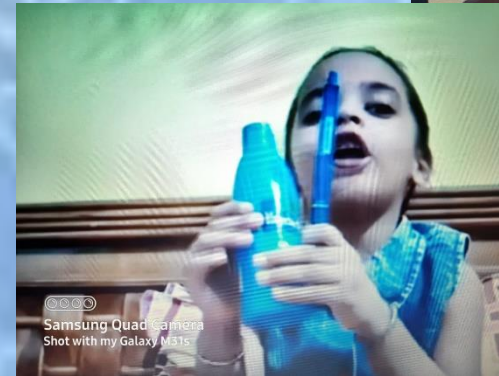

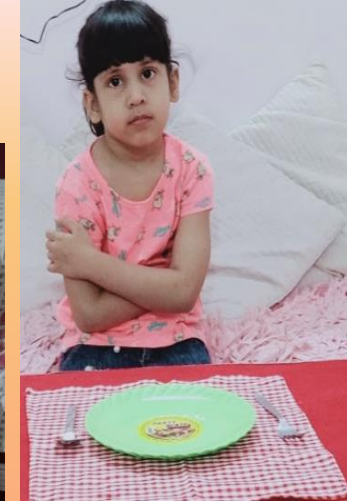
BLUE COLOUR

LEARNING TO BEING INDEPENDENT

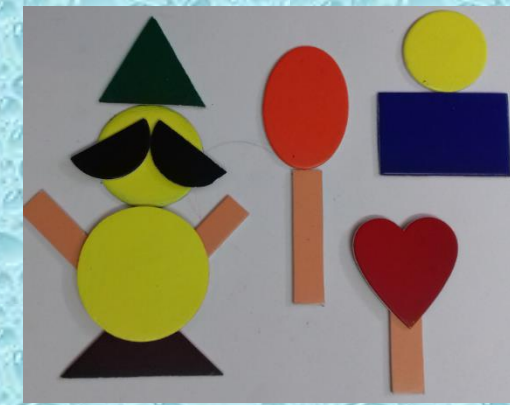

Children made figures and objects with the help of shape box. It increases the imagination and recognition of shapes

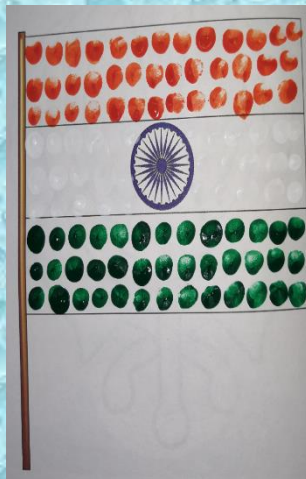

Children did painting with finger tip and made fruits.



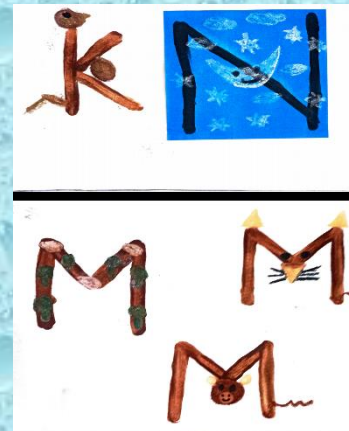
Children made tri-colour badges with paper. This gave them a sense of patriotism.

Children made fruit bookmarks with paper folding.

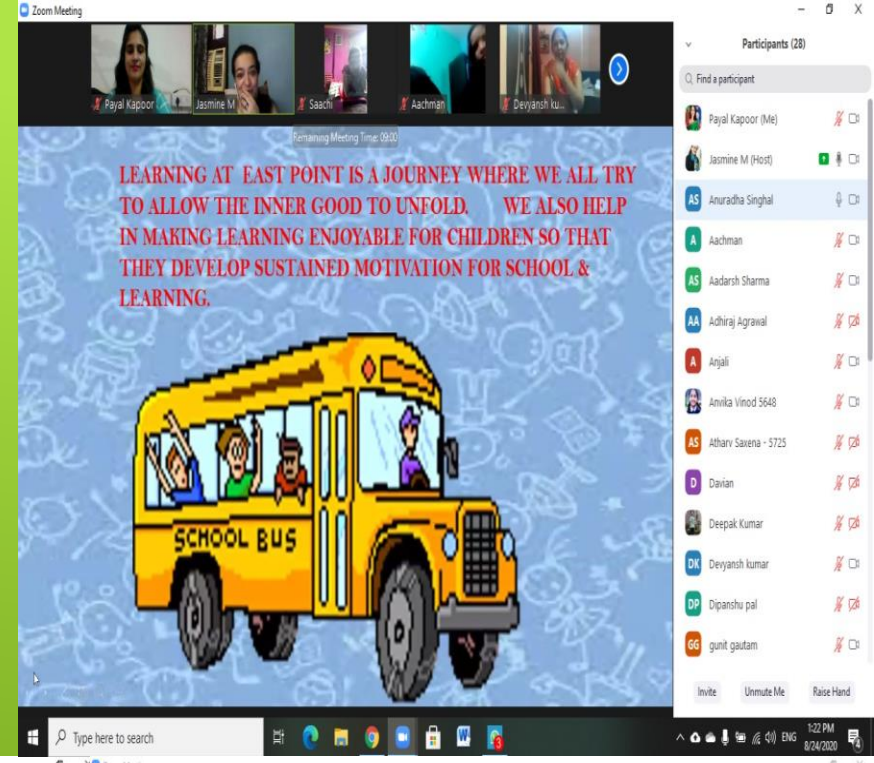


Children made Peacock feathered crown on the occasion of Janamashtami.
