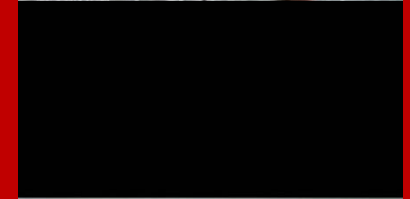

ENGLISH WEEK

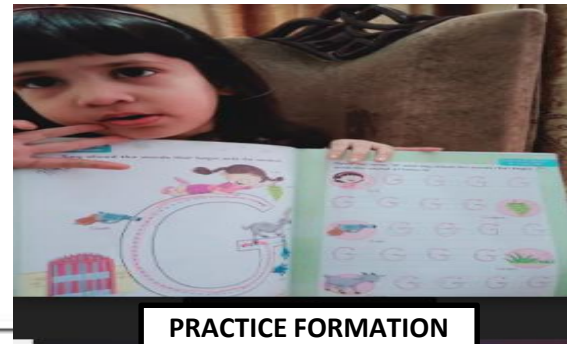

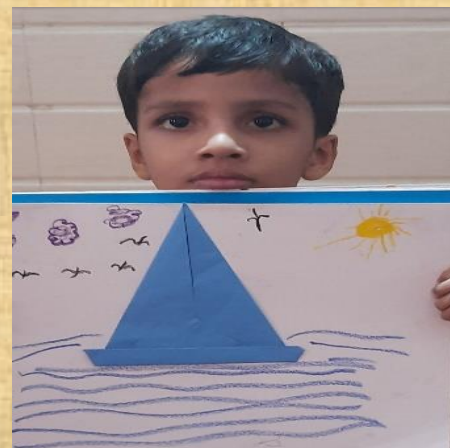

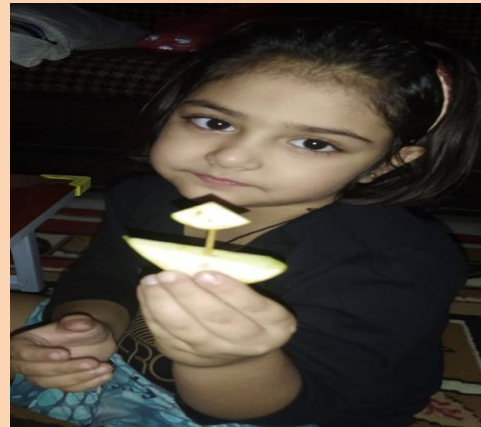
