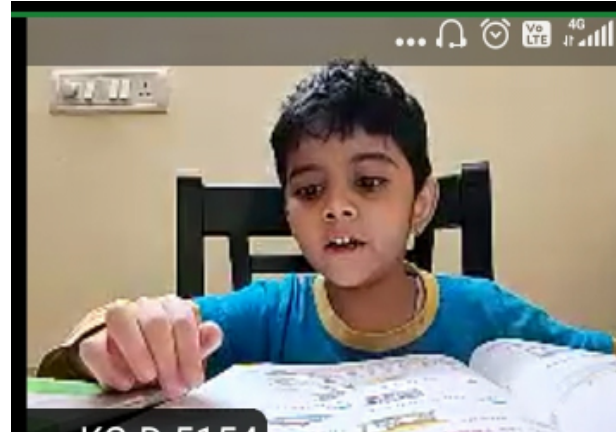
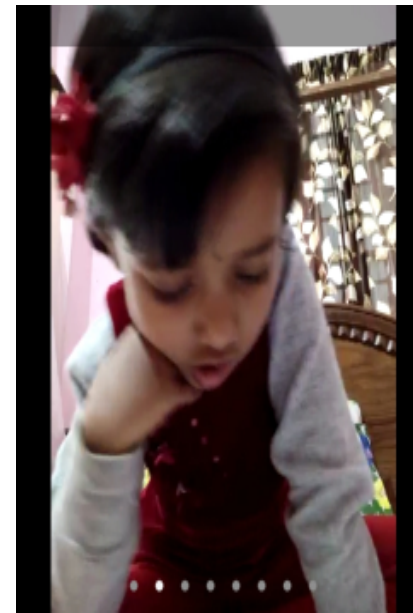

To inculcate the habit of reading, “DEAR activity” was conducted in KG. The activity boosted their confidence while reading and also developed their vocabulary.





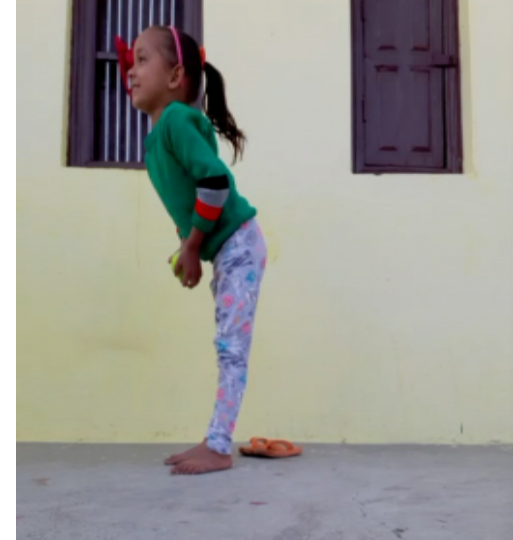


# **VIRTUAL SPORTS** **FIESTA**

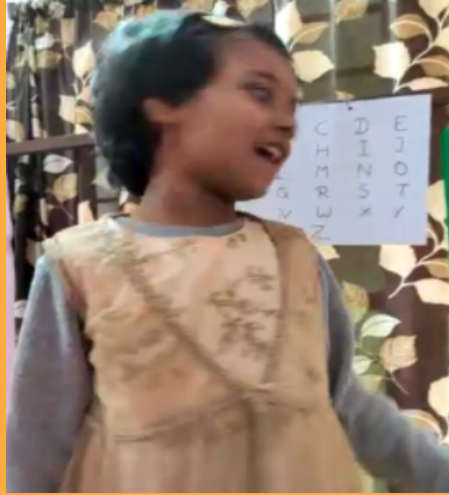
- Virtual field trips are a way of enhancing classrooms learning by making real world connections.

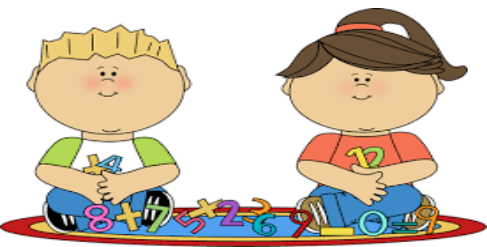

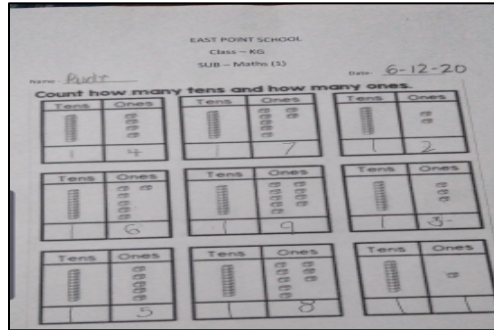

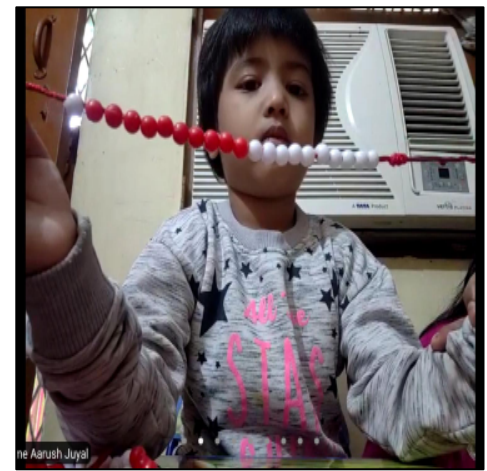
