Fun with Ice

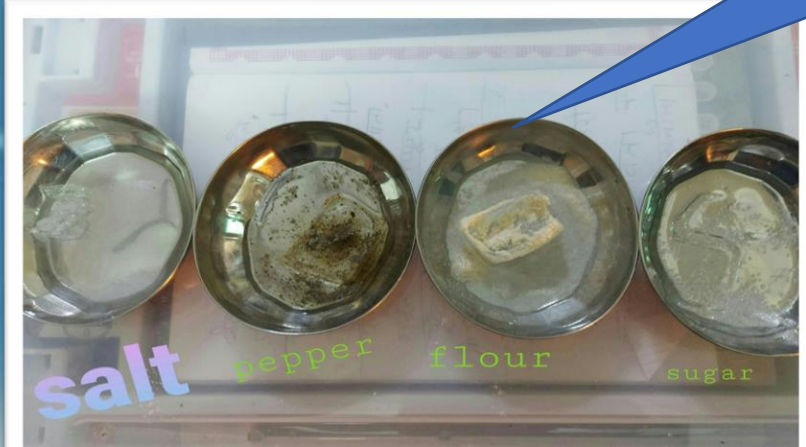
The ice with flour took the most time to melt.

When we sprinkled salt on ice, it melted very fast.



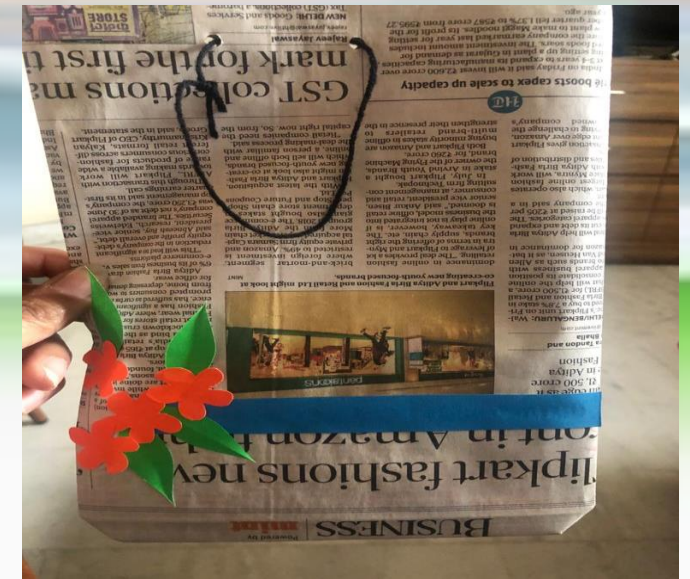

To inculcate the value of patriotism in the children, they made paper bags and decorated them with tri-colour.

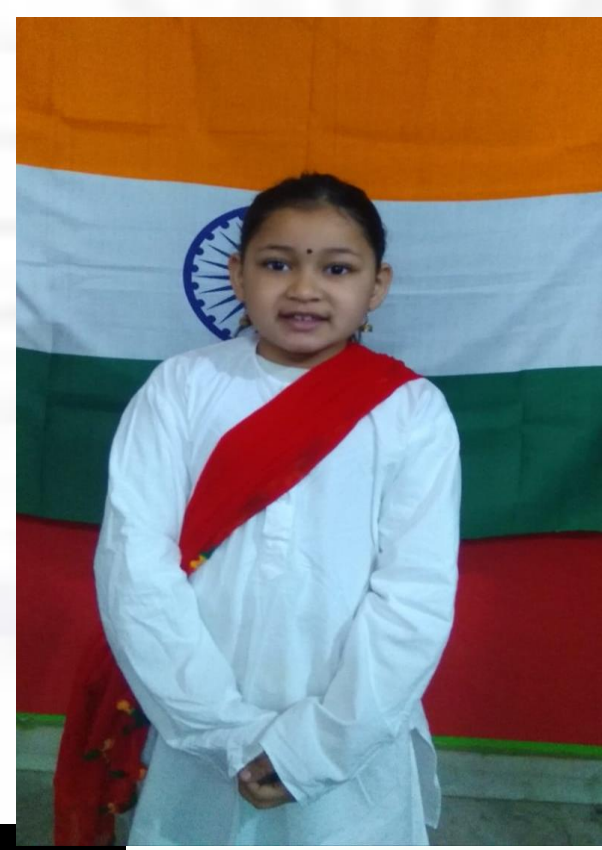

MINAR-e-PAKISTAN

- **Minar-e-Pakistan** is a national monument located in Lahore, Pakistan.
- The tower was built between 1960 and 1968 on the site where the All-India Muslim League passed the Lahore Resolution on 23 March 1940 - the first official call for a separate and independent homeland for the Muslims of British India, as espoused by the two-nation theory.
- The tower reflects a blend of Mughal/Islamic and modern architecture.
- The tower was designed and supervised by, Nasreddin Murat-Khan a Russian-born Pakistani architect and civil engineer
- Minar-e-Pakistan has served as the location for a number of rallies

(Pakistan Monument)

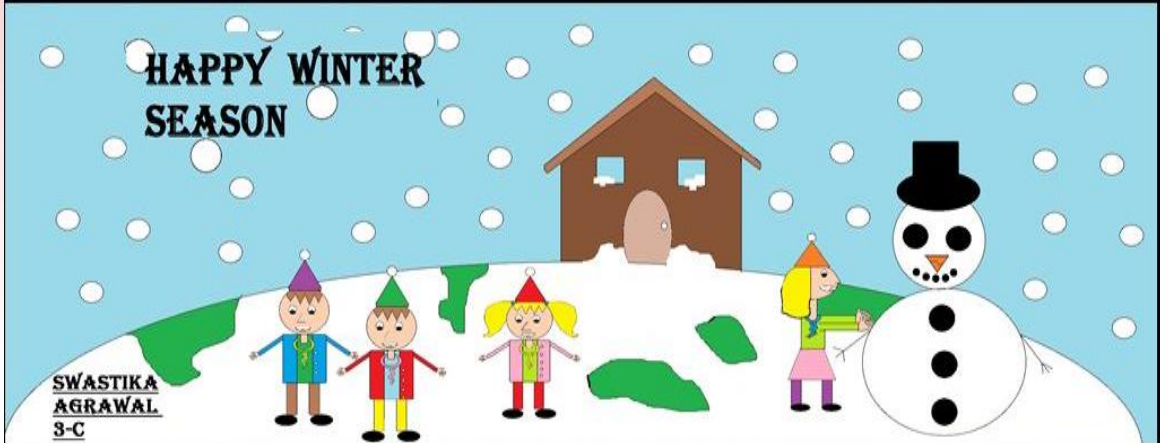
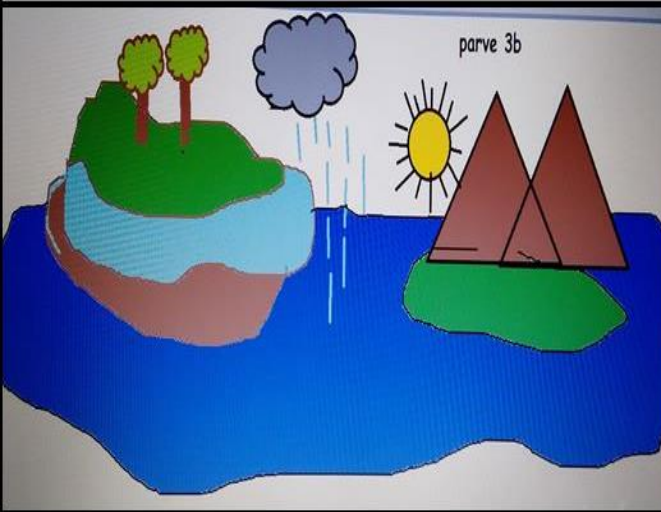
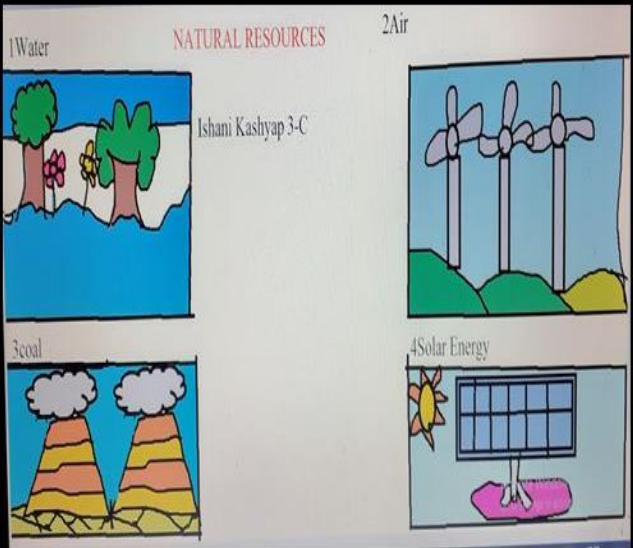
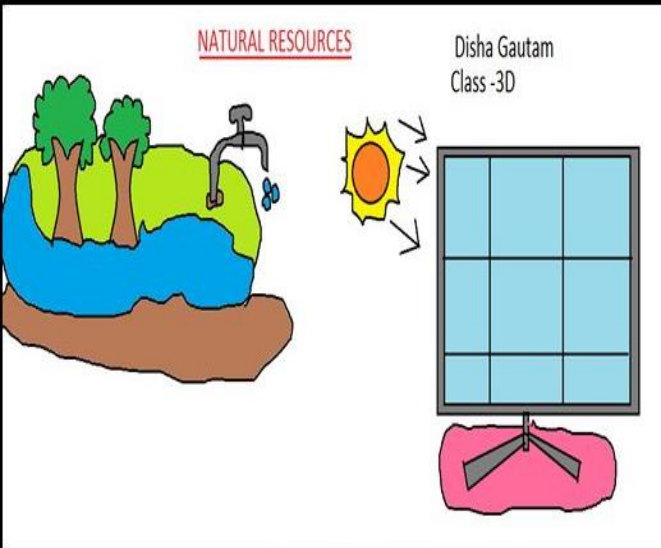
The Gumti Water Fountain is a monument in Faisalabad, Pakistan preserved from the British Raj Era. It was built during the early nineteenth century.

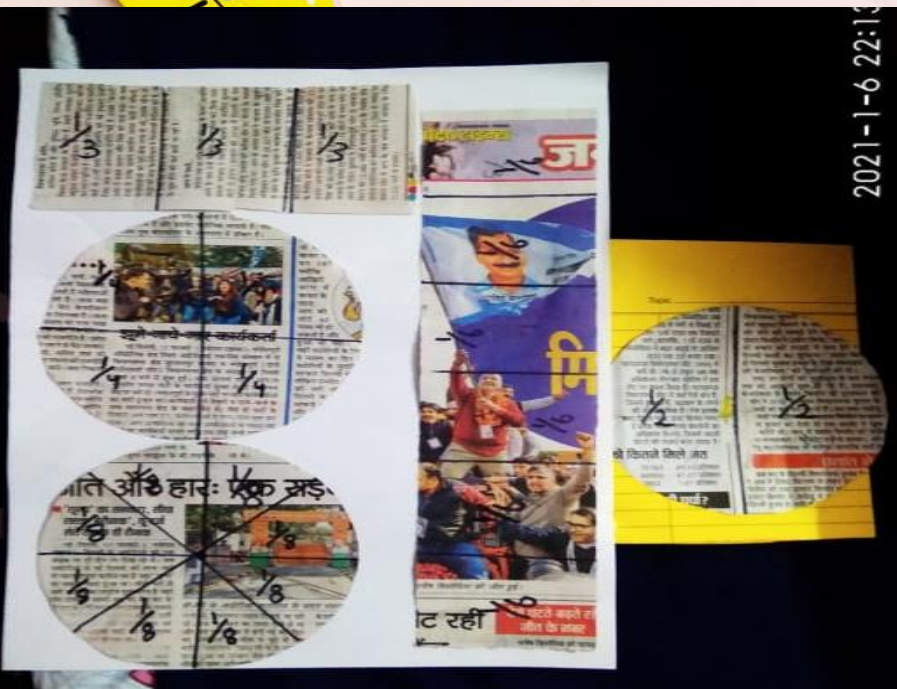
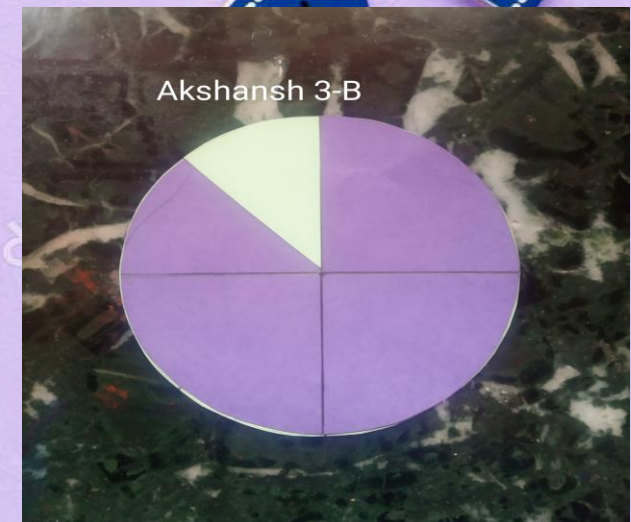


Fun with Fractions

बीर सूखा कचरा ?

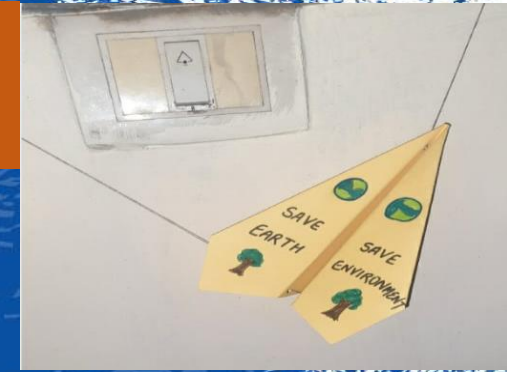
