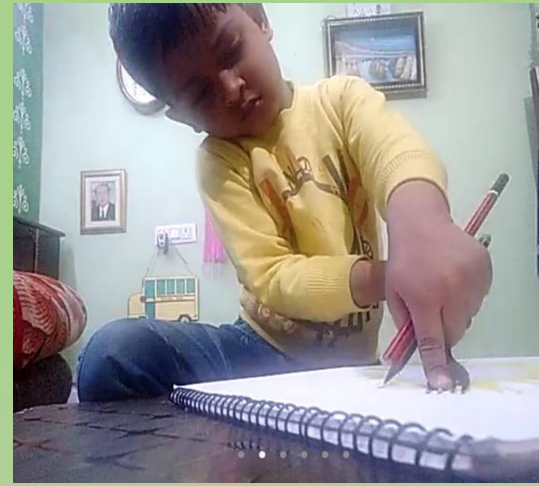


# ENGLISH RHYME RECITATION

The learner developed reasoning skills by understanding the concept of Time and how things around them change.

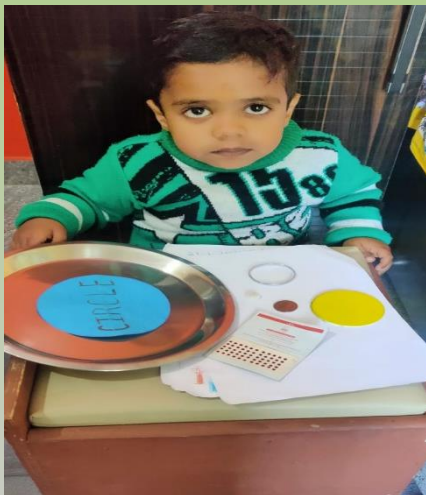
Children did projects on the topic, "Up in the sky".

- ❖ Various pre-number concepts through objects available at home.

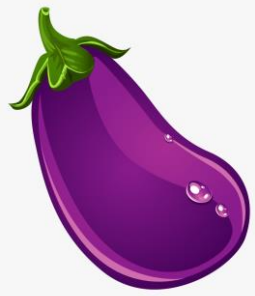


# UP IN THE SKY

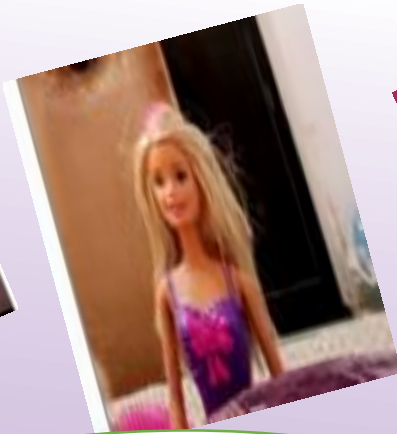
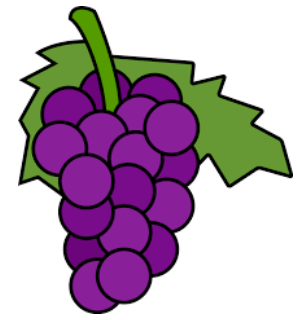
To get students into noticing & describing what objects in the sky look like at different time of the day, various activities were done to engage students in direct observation of both Day & Night sky like:
